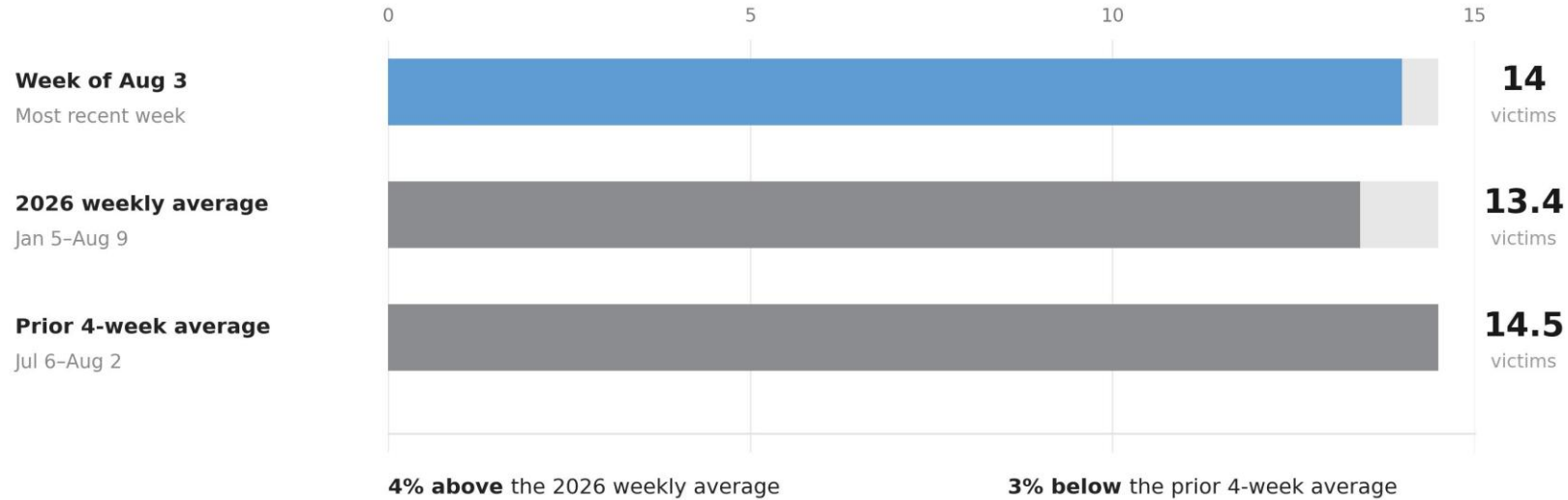

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Philadelphia Shooting Victims - Latest Week vs. Benchmarks

Week of August 3, 2026 compared with the 2026 and prior 4-week averages



- There were 14 shooting victims during the week of August 3rd.
- For 2026 calendar year to date, there has been an average of 13.4 shooting victims per week.
- In the 4 prior weeks (7/6 – 8/2), there was an average of 14.5 weekly shooting victims.
 - This represents a continued cooling of total victimization in recent weeks since an early-summer surge, when there was an average of 21.3 weekly victims in the 4 weeks from 6/15 – 7/12.

Key Takeaways

- For the week of August 3rd – August 9th, across the City of Philadelphia, there were: 12 documented shooting incidents, 14 documented shooting victims, and 7 documented shooting fatalities.
 - A review of news stories reveals a discrepancy of 2 additional shooting victims reported in the news and not included in the public dataset; 1 nonfatal shooting in Cobbs Creek that was entirely absent, and a second victim in a shooting incident in Nicetown-Tioga that appears as a single-victim shooting in public data.
- While the number of total reported shooting victims this week (14) was close to the 2026 year-to-date weekly average (13.4 victims per week), shooting incidents this week were more lethal.
 - A full 50% of shooting victims this week lost their lives (7 of 14). For 2026 to date, 22% of shooting victims have lost their lives.
 - A closer look at news stories reveals no clear cause for this week's elevated fatality rate.
 - All 7 fatal shootings this week had no clear motive outlined from police in published news stories; over the last 2 weeks, 10 of 11 fatal incidents had no clearly identified motive immediately identified in new stories.
 - This week, 2 victims were fatally shot while driving vehicles, 3 appear to have been found shot in the street, 1 was shot on a porch with her husband, and 1 chased by 2 suspects behind an apartment complex and shot multiple times.

Key Takeaways

- Violence in Nicetown-Tioga has continued to surge. There has been at least 1 shooting in Nicetown-Tioga in 8 of the last 9 weeks, and multiple incidents in 7 of the last 9 weeks.
 - *From Jan 2025 – Aug 2026, the neighborhood has accounted for approximately 9% of all City violence. This has jumped to 18% over the last 4 weeks, and 25% this week. (See table below)*

Key Takeaways

- Public data indicates there were 7 shooting victims on Sunday, 8/9. This equals the fifth most violent single day this calendar year.
 - Reconciliations of the public data show an additional 2 shooting victims. Stakeholders should give closer examination to incidents on this day to determine if any key factors may have led to elevated levels of violence.
- As of 8/9/26, there were 424 reported shooting victims for calendar year 2026; this marks an approximate 35% decrease from the same timeframe in 2025, when there were 652 reported shooting victims.
 - There was a 1% lessening of the total between-year victimization gap from the previous week (36% to 35%).
- As of 8/9/26, there were 94 reported shooting fatalities for calendar year 2026; this marks an approximate 28% decrease from the same timeframe in 2025, when there were 131 reported shooting victims.
 - The 7 fatal shootings this week led to a 5% lessening of the total between-year fatality gap from the previous week (33% to 28%).

A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- Of the 12 documented shooting incidents, 11 received dedicated coverage on local news outlets (92%). An additional (twelfth) incident was reported in the news that was not in the public dataset. Of these stories:
 - 1 of 12 (8%) described a shooting appearing to stem from an escalation of a physical or verbal arguments/fight:
 - An 18 y/o male victim was shot by another man at a house party following a physical altercation between a group of women.
 - 3 of 12 (25%) describe what details would suggest are likely targeted shootings, but with unknown motives:
 - A 22 y/o man was shot in the chest inside the bedroom of a home, with shell casings suggesting a suspect was standing outside and firing into the home.
 - A 26 y/o victim was found shot in the chest behind an apartment complex after 2 suspects allegedly chased him down and fired at least 20 shots.
 - Directly outside the emergency room at Temple University Hospital, a car stopped in front of a parked van and two gunmen fired multiple shots. Two men were shot according to news reports (only 1 appears in the public dataset).

A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- 8 of 12 (67%) stories outlined shooting incidents with no indication of a potential motive.
 - A 32 y/o man was found shot multiple times in the street; he was taken to the hospital where he died.
 - A 26 y/o man was found unresponsive after being shot in the shoulder inside of an SUV with the driver's side door open and lights on; he was transported to Penn Presbyterian where he was in stable condition.
 - A 31 y/o male was shot near 20th and Susquehanna Ave; he was taken to Temple University Hospital where he was pronounced.
 - A 70 y/o man was driving when he was fatally shot once in the chest, continued driving, and crashed into a parked vehicle.
 - A 34 y/o and 30 y/o man were shot, 1 fatally and 1 nonfatally. 1 man was found shot inside a crashed gray Infinity at 3:15 AM, rushed to the hospital, and died. The second man arrived to the hospital on his own with multiple gunshot wounds and was in stable condition.
 - A 32 y/o woman was shot on the 2700 Block of N Hemberger St, when "police say a preliminary investigation revealed the woman was at the location when someone began firing." The victim then arrived at Temple University Hospital a short time after with multiple gunshot wounds and was in stable condition.

A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- A news article simply reports that - "a 42-year-old man was shot on the 6200 Block of Woodland Ave." No further details provided. This was a fatal shooting.
- Partners of a 60+ y/o married couple were shot multiple times when over 20 shots were fired outside their home, seemingly on their porch. They were taken to the hospital, where 61 y/o Michelle Wilson was pronounced dead. Her husband was in stable condition. Police looking into whether they were the intended targets or shot by stray bullets stated - "it would be unclear why they would be targeted." Video shows a man "wearing a baseball cap and medical mask" approaching the scene and moving a handgun from a bag to inside his coat before the shooting.

This is the same number of incidents from the previous week; there was a 1-victim and 3-fatality increase.

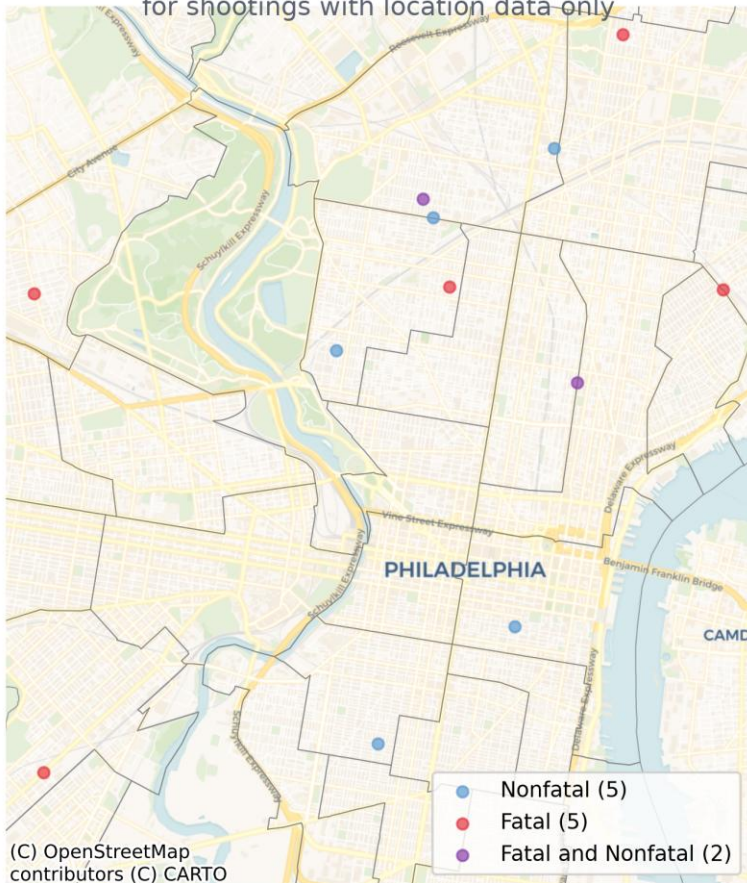

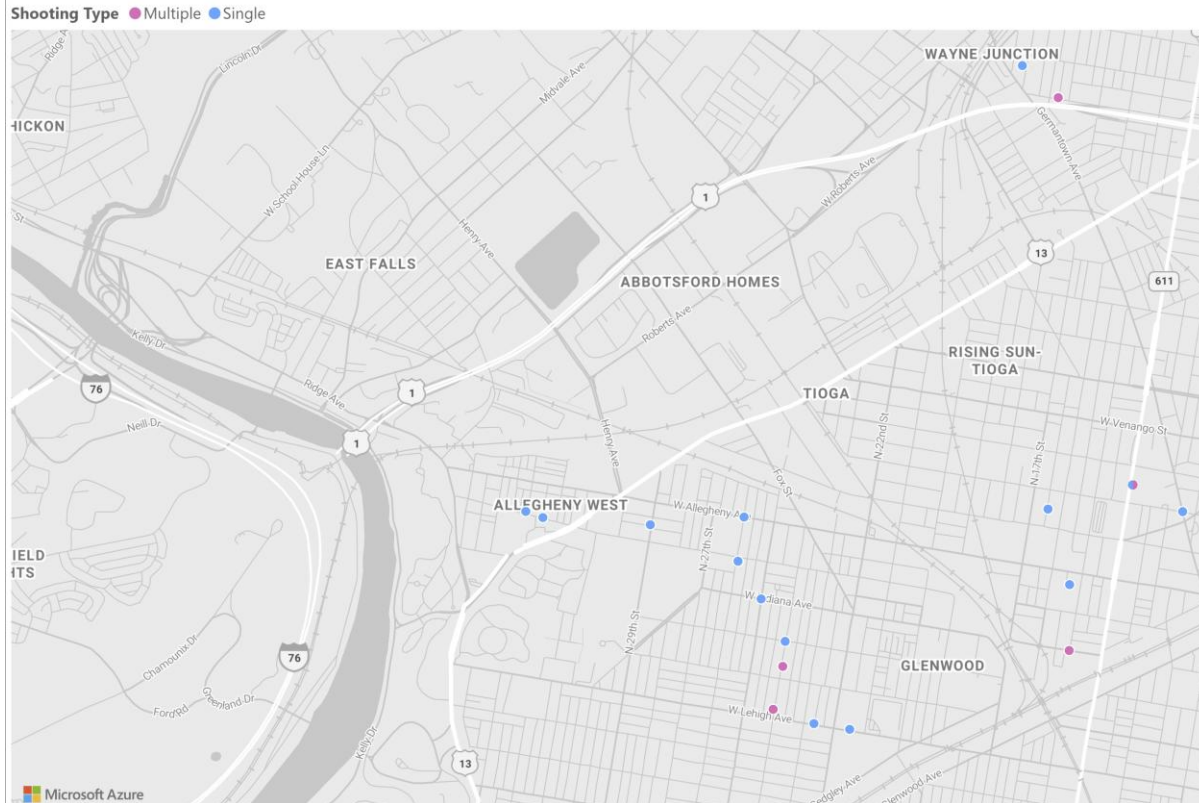

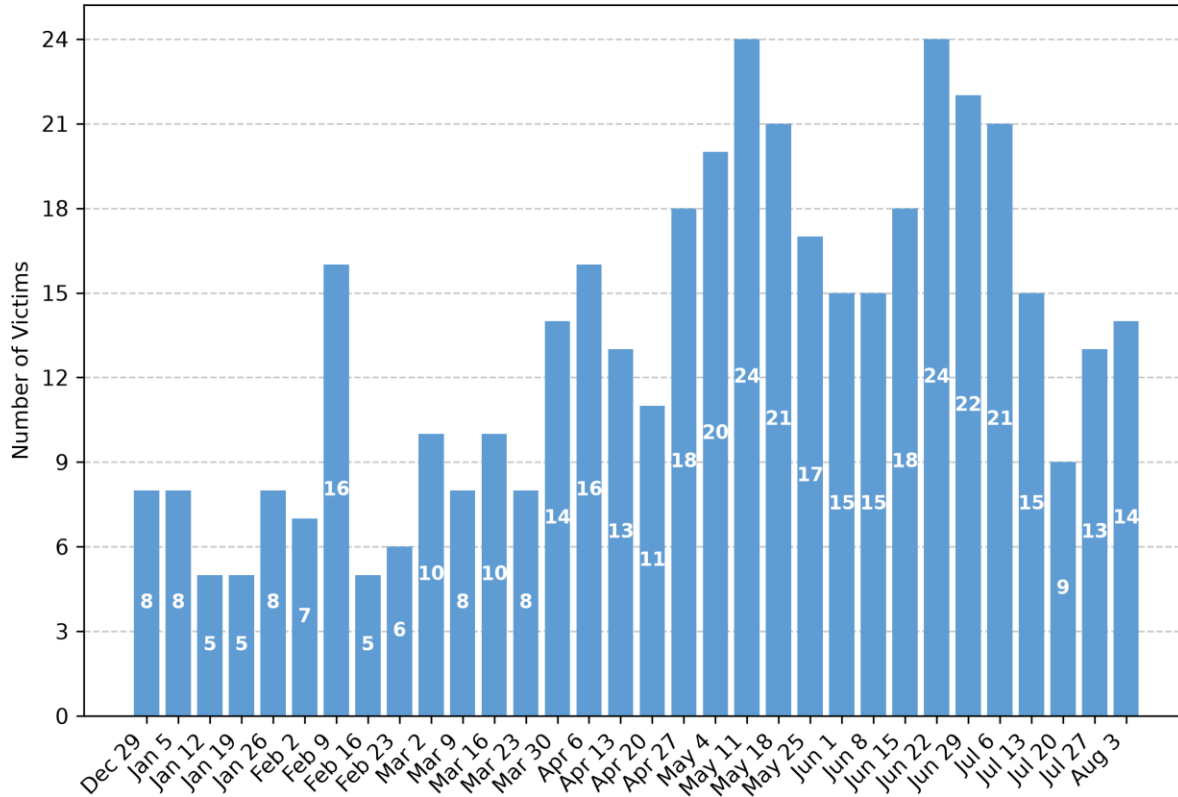
- On Monday, 8/3, at 2:00 AM, around Walton Ave & S 60th St in the Cobbs Creek neighborhood of the 19143 ZIP code, a 26 y/o male was found unresponsive after being shot in the shoulder inside of an SUV. Driver's side door remained open and the lights were on. He was transported to Penn Presbyterian where he was in stable condition. DISCREPANCIES FROM PUBLIC DATA

- On Sunday, 8/9, at 11:53 AM, on the 3400 Block of Germantown Ave in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood of the 19140 ZIP code, directly outside of the emergency room at Temple University Hospital (TUH), a car stopped in front of a parked van and two gunmen fired multiple shots. 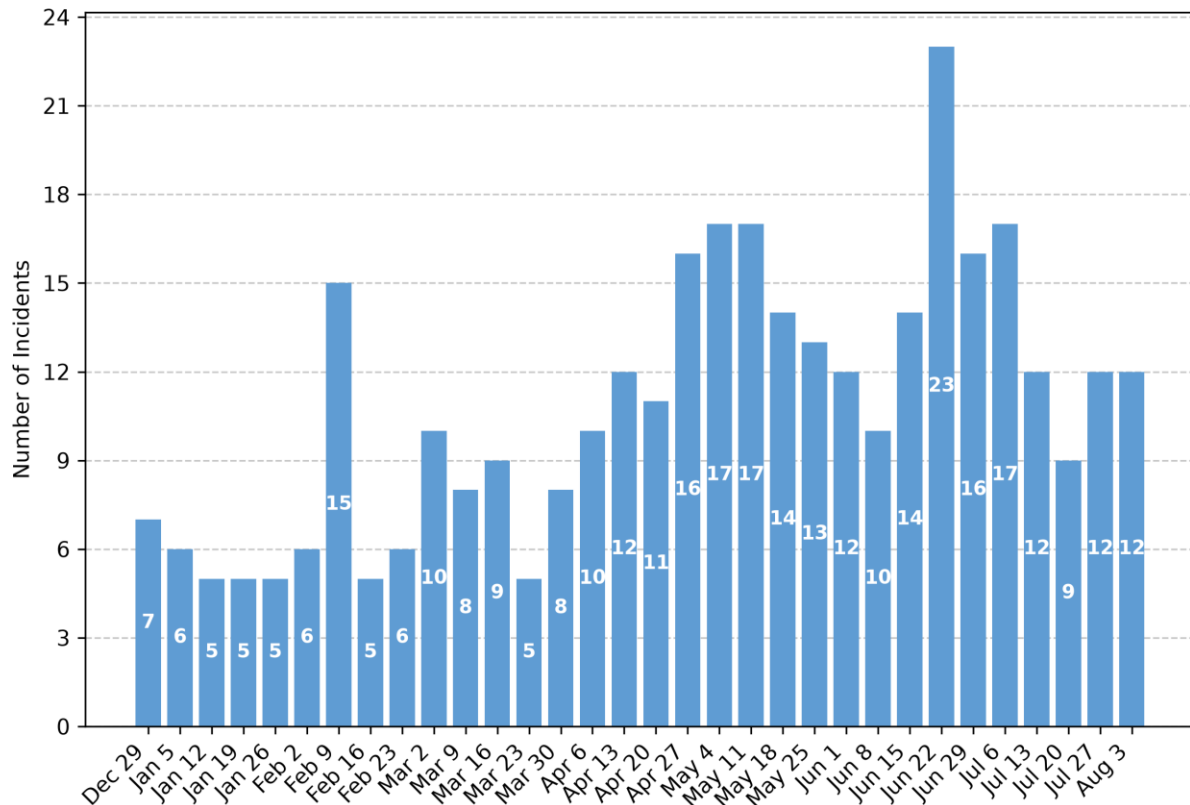


The week of August 3rd saw a 1-victim increase in the number of total reported shooting victims (14) from the previous week (13).

Following a 4-week period of escalated violence (weeks of 6/15 – 7/6) and a substantial drop the week of July 20th (9), the 13 and 14 shooting victims the last two weeks mark a return to average weekly victimization totals for calendar year 2026 (13.4).

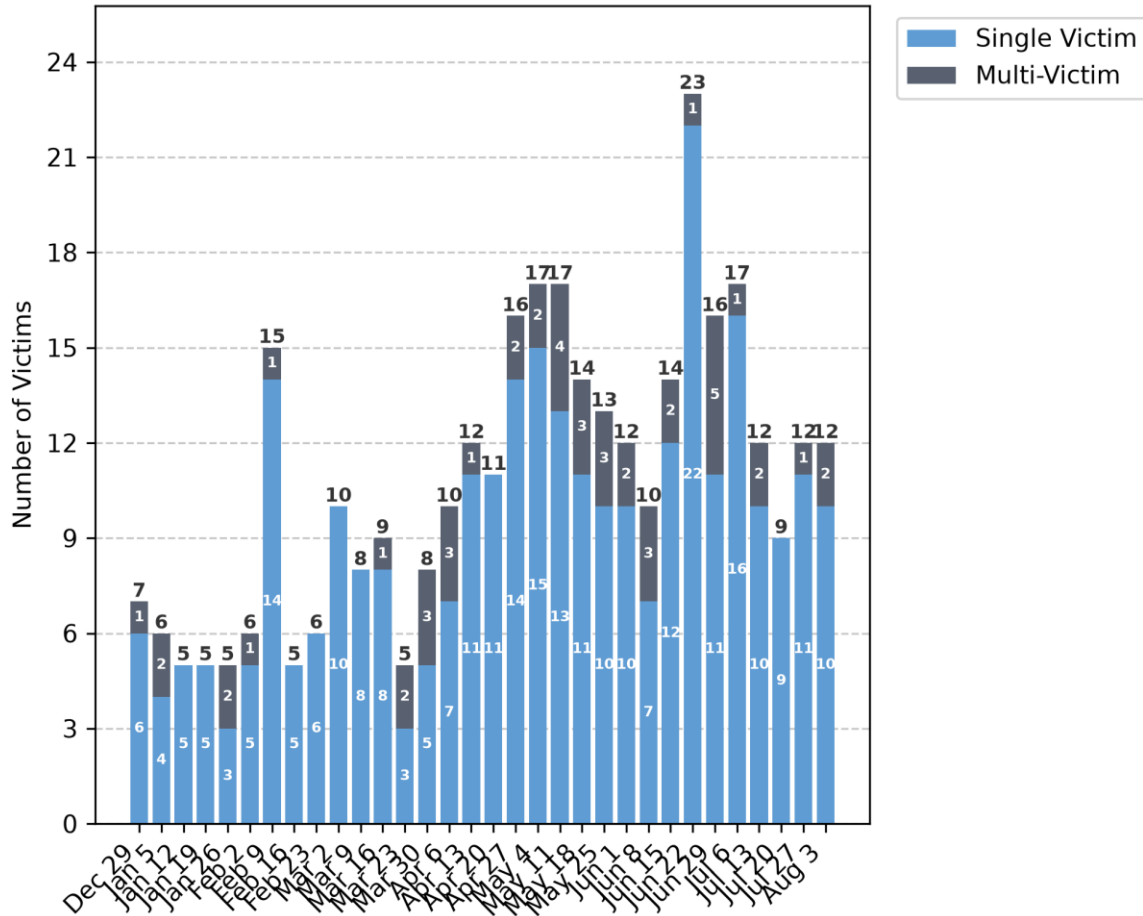


There were 12 individual shooting incidents during the week of August 3rd.

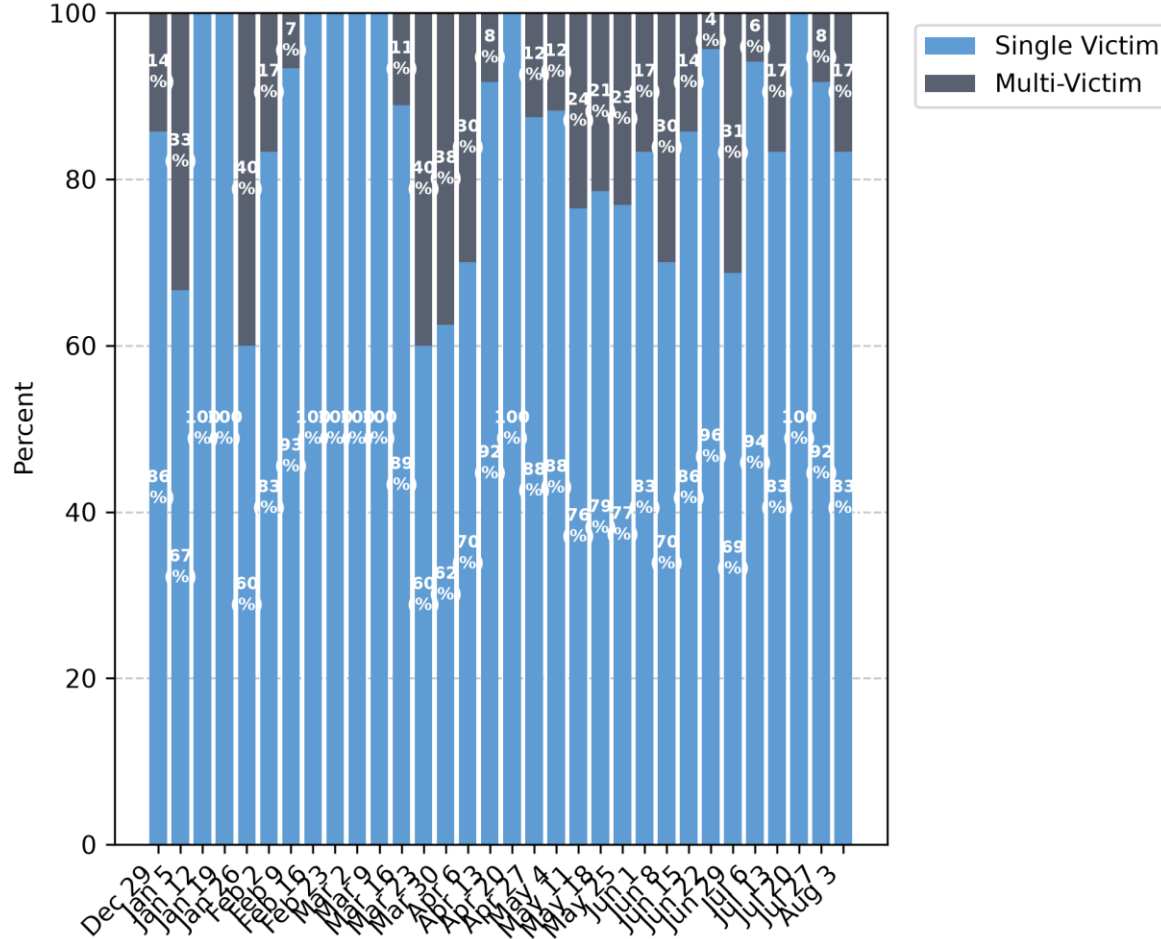


The 14 total shooting victims during the week of August 3rd were the result of 12 individual shooting incidents.

- There were 2 multi-victim shooting incident(s) in the public dataset for the week of August 3rd.
 - Of note, there are numerous discrepancies in the public data related to public shootings.
 - As seen above, a shooting on the 600 Block of W Oxford St appears to be a multi-victim shooting, both due to shared a DC # as well as details included in news reports. The public dataset appears to incorrectly list 1 shooting victim as having been shot on Saturday, 8/8, at 11:19 PM, however.
 - As indicated in the prior “Reconciling News Stories and Public Dataset” slide, news reports indicate there was a third multi-victim shooting this week, with 1 victim simply not included in the public dataset.

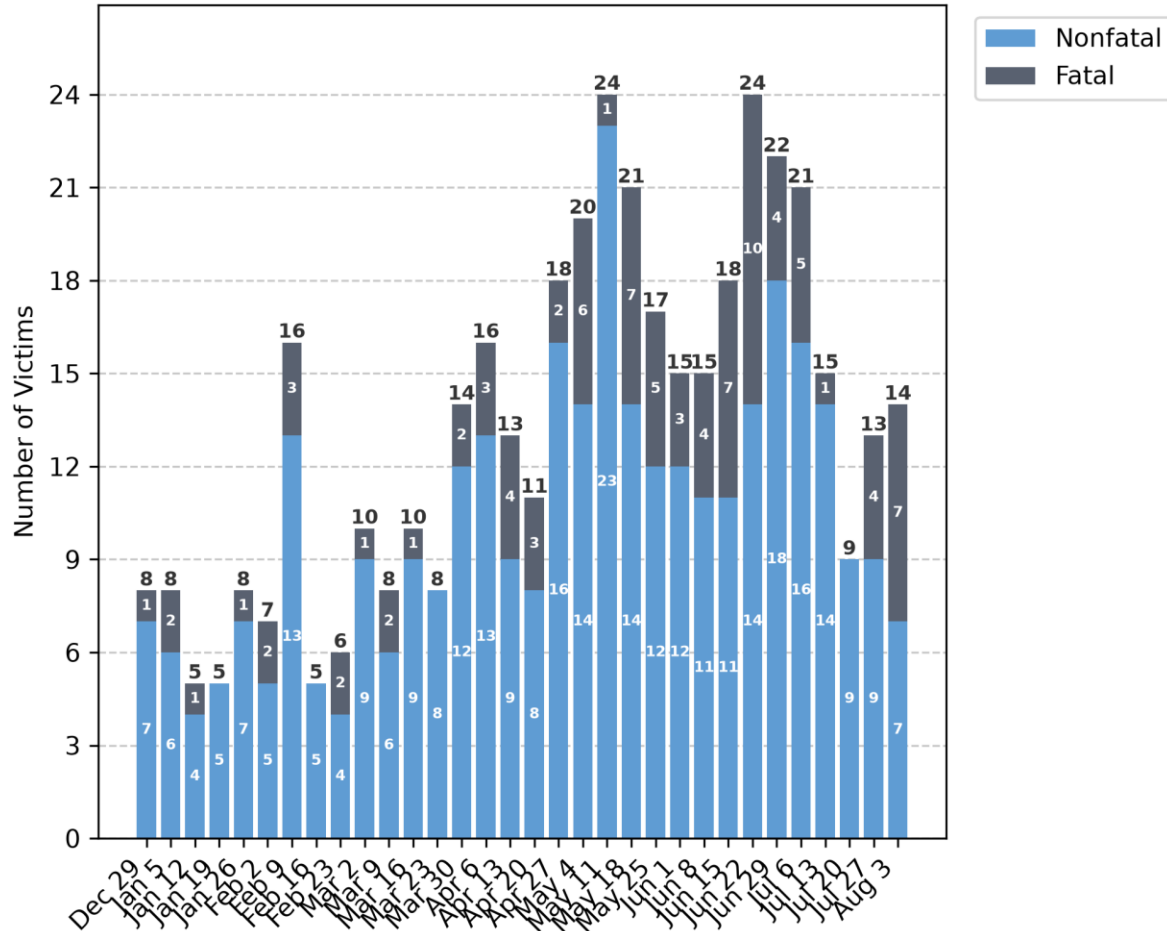

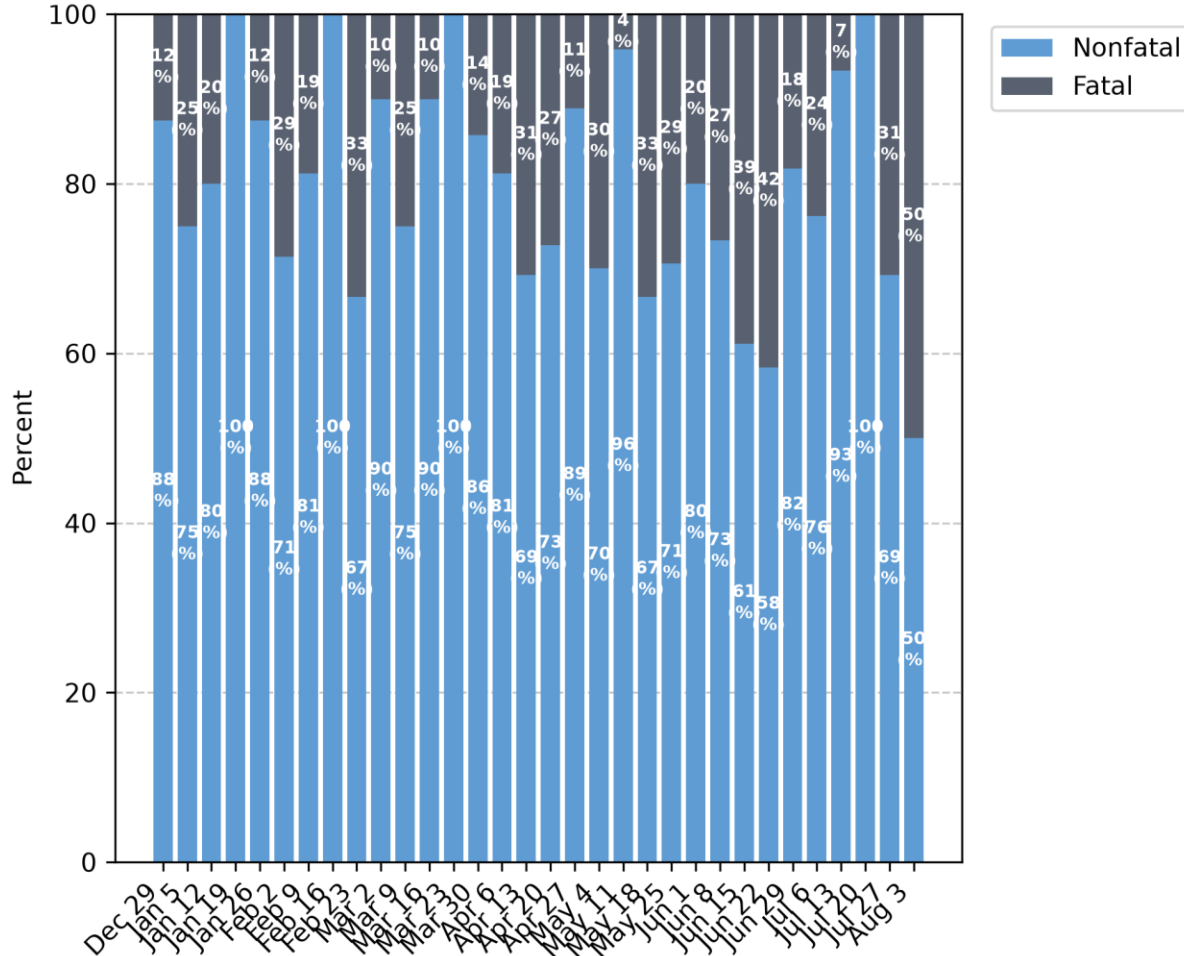
Of the 14 shooting victims during the week of August 3rd, there were 7 victims who lost their lives.

- There were 7 fatal shootings in the public data for the week of August 3rd.
 - All 7 fatal shooting victims were males.
 - 4 of the 7 fatalities happened on Sunday, 8/9, in separate incidents across the city.

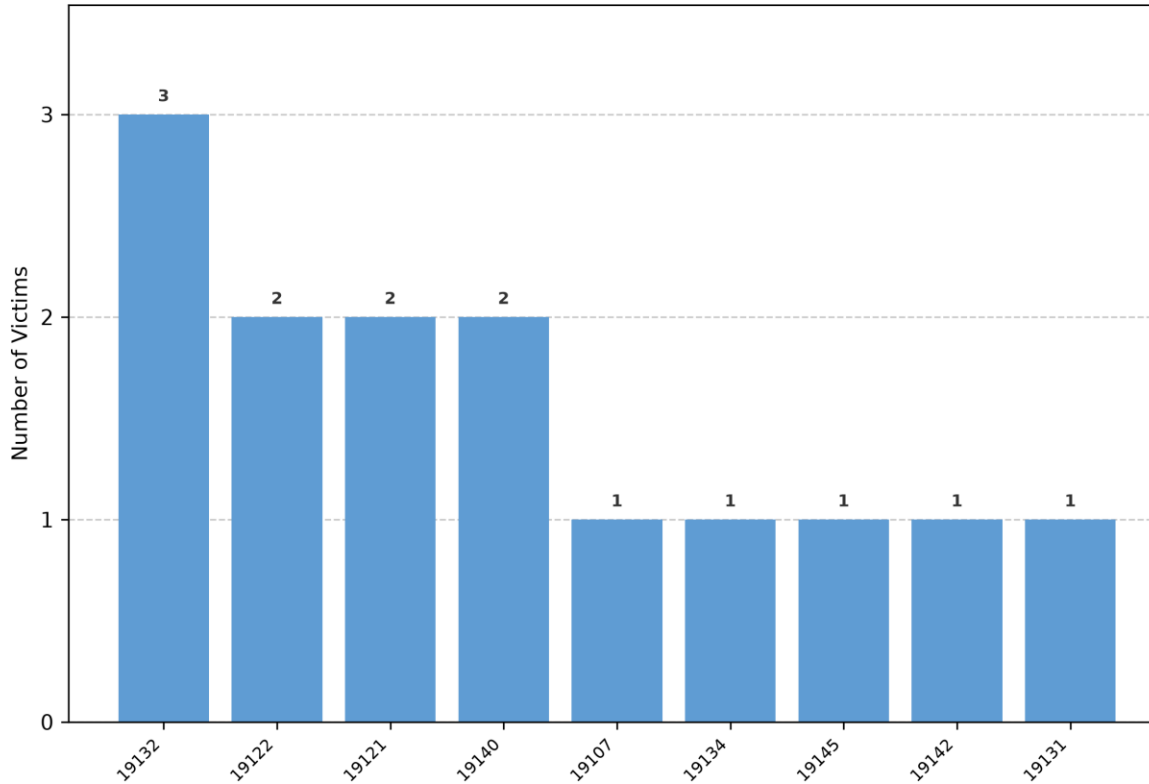

The 19122, 19121, and 19140 ZIP codes also had multiple shooting victims.

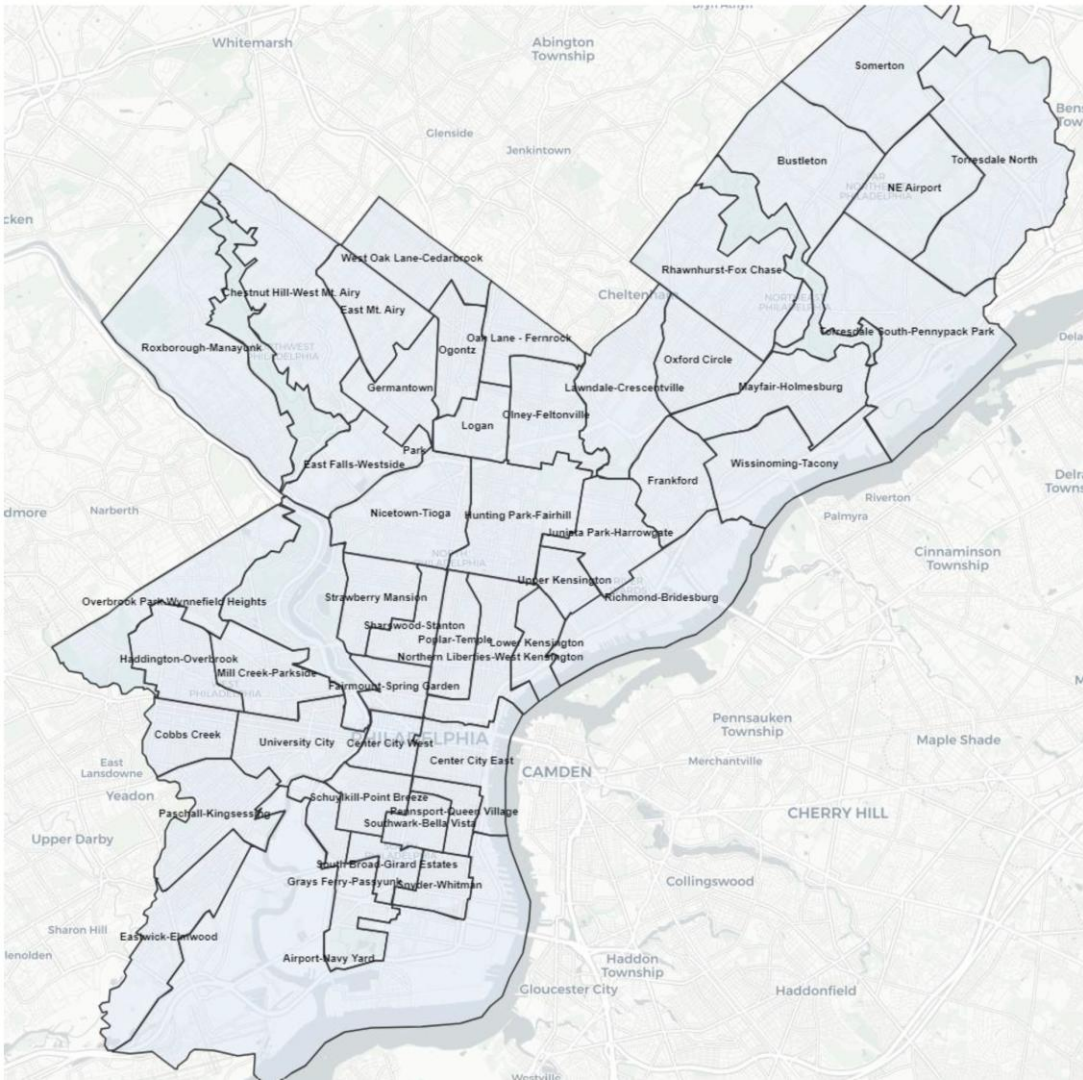

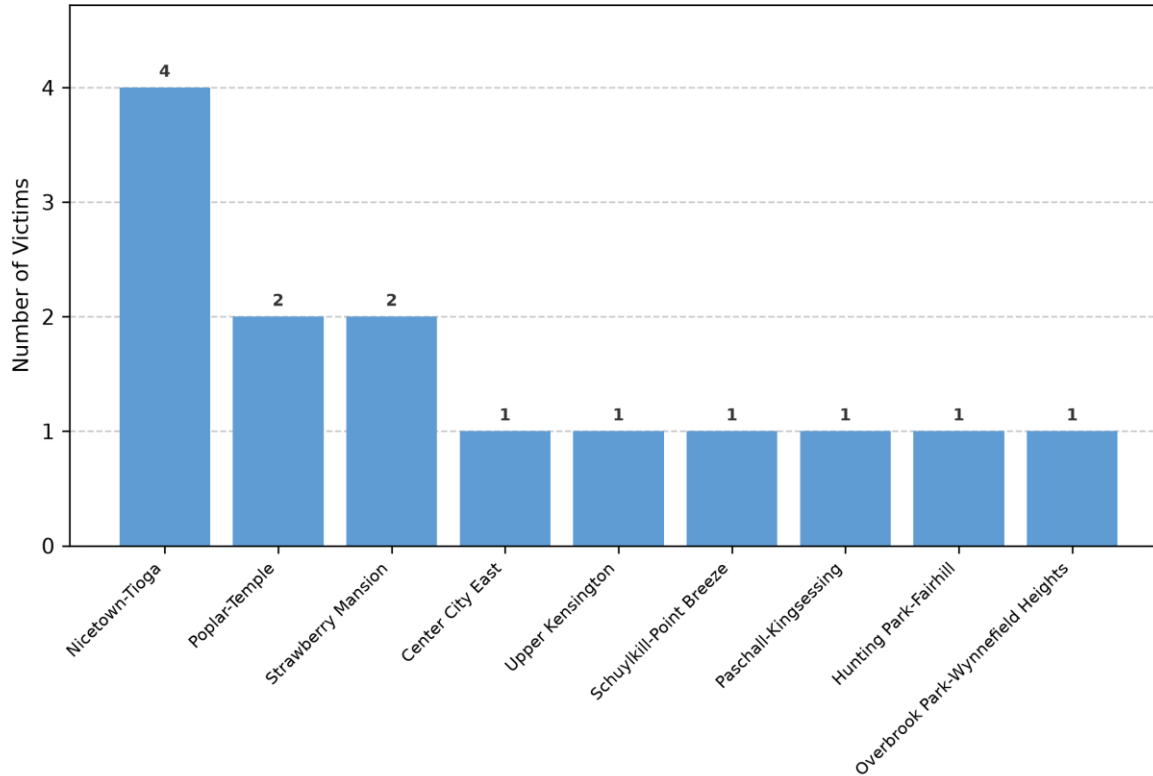

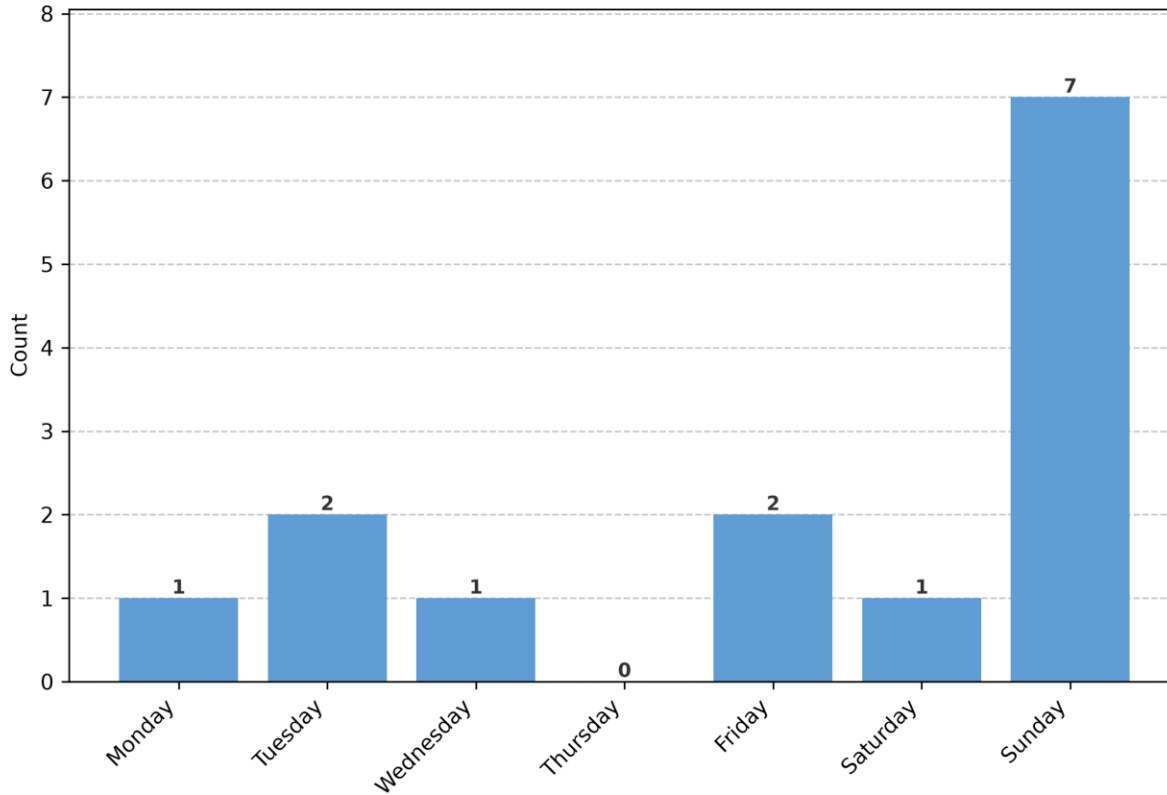

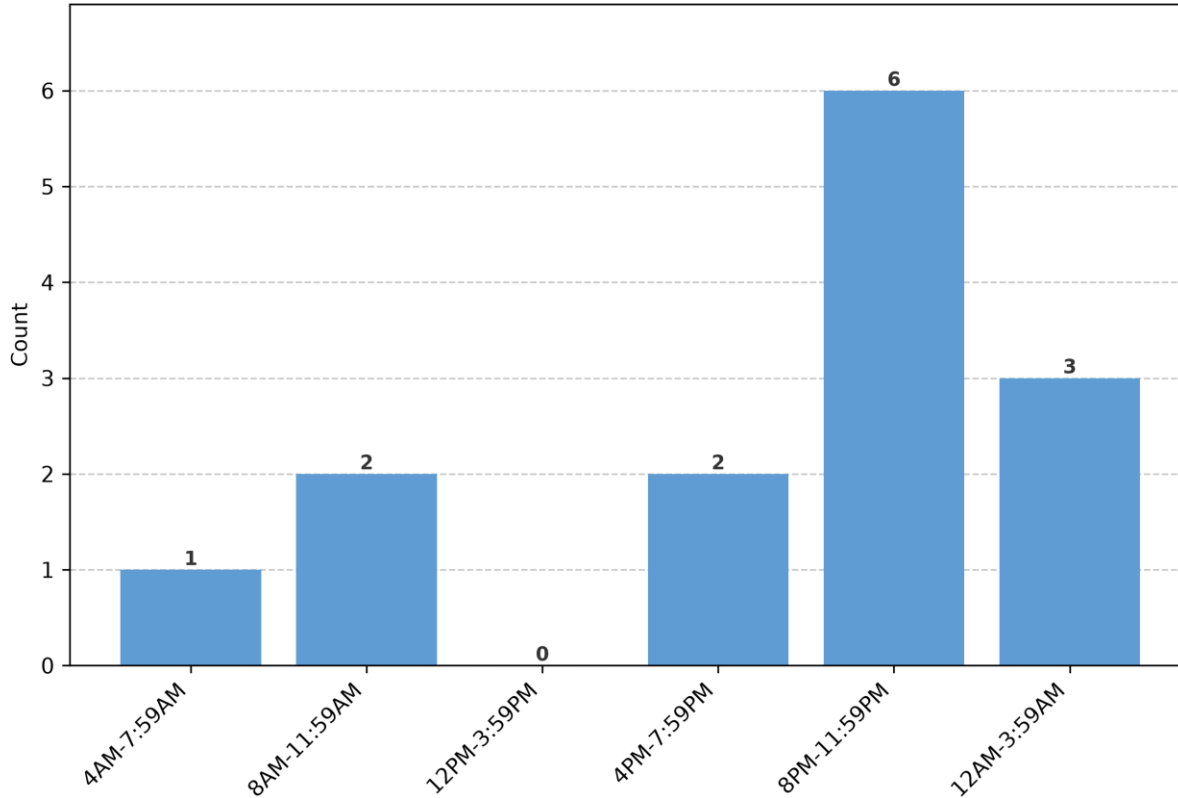
There were no shootings in the City of Philadelphia on Thursday, 8/6.

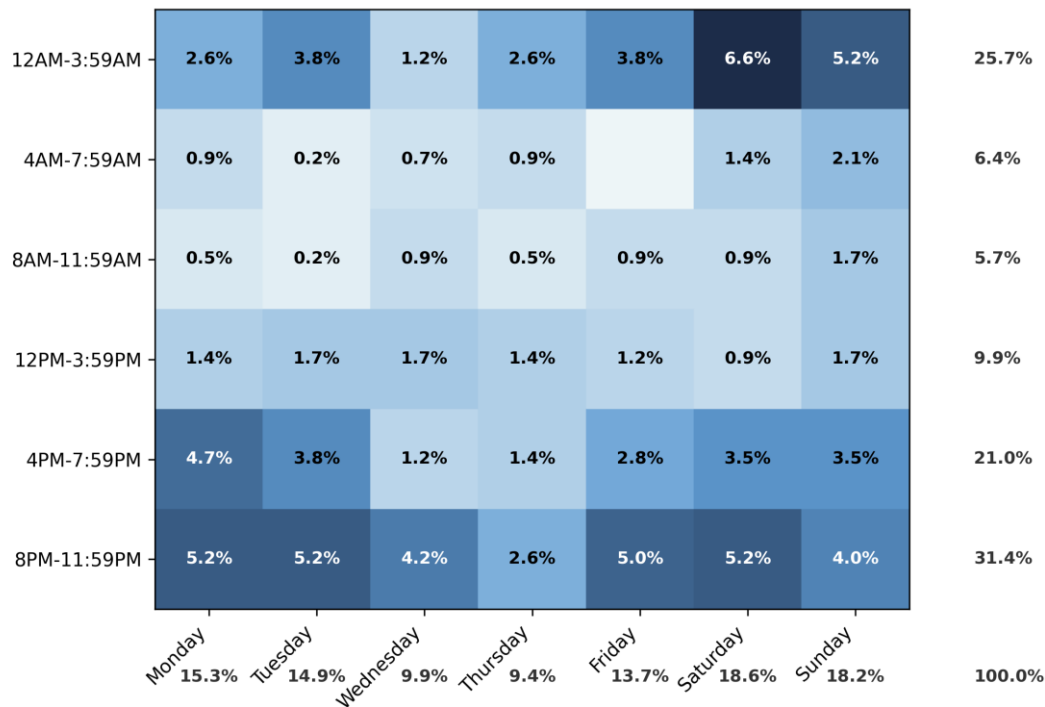


The most victims (n:6, 43%) were shot between the hours of 8:00 PM and 11:59 PM.

For the calendar year, the most victims have been shot on a Saturday (18.6%) or Sunday (18.2%).

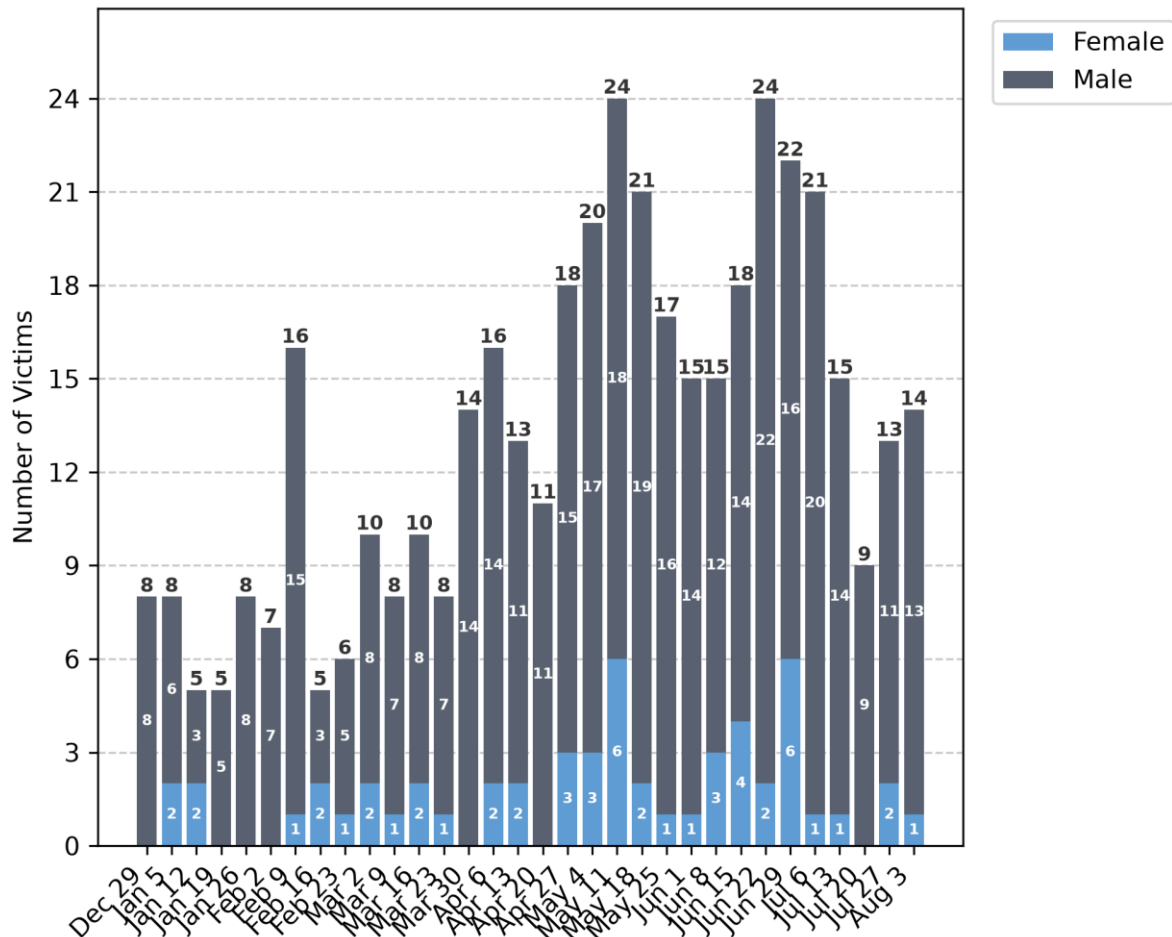
The most victims have been shot in the 8:00 PM – 11:59 PM window (31.4%).

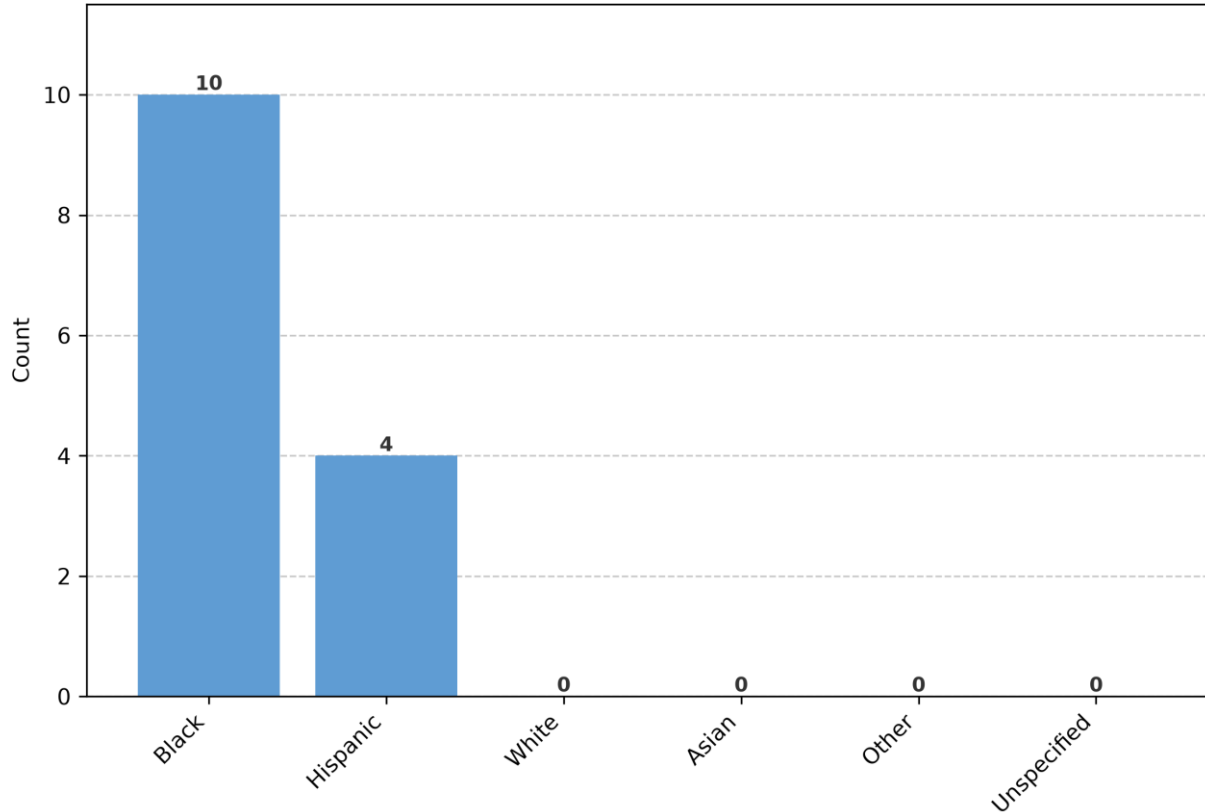


13 of 14 shooting victims (93%) during the week of August 3rd were male.

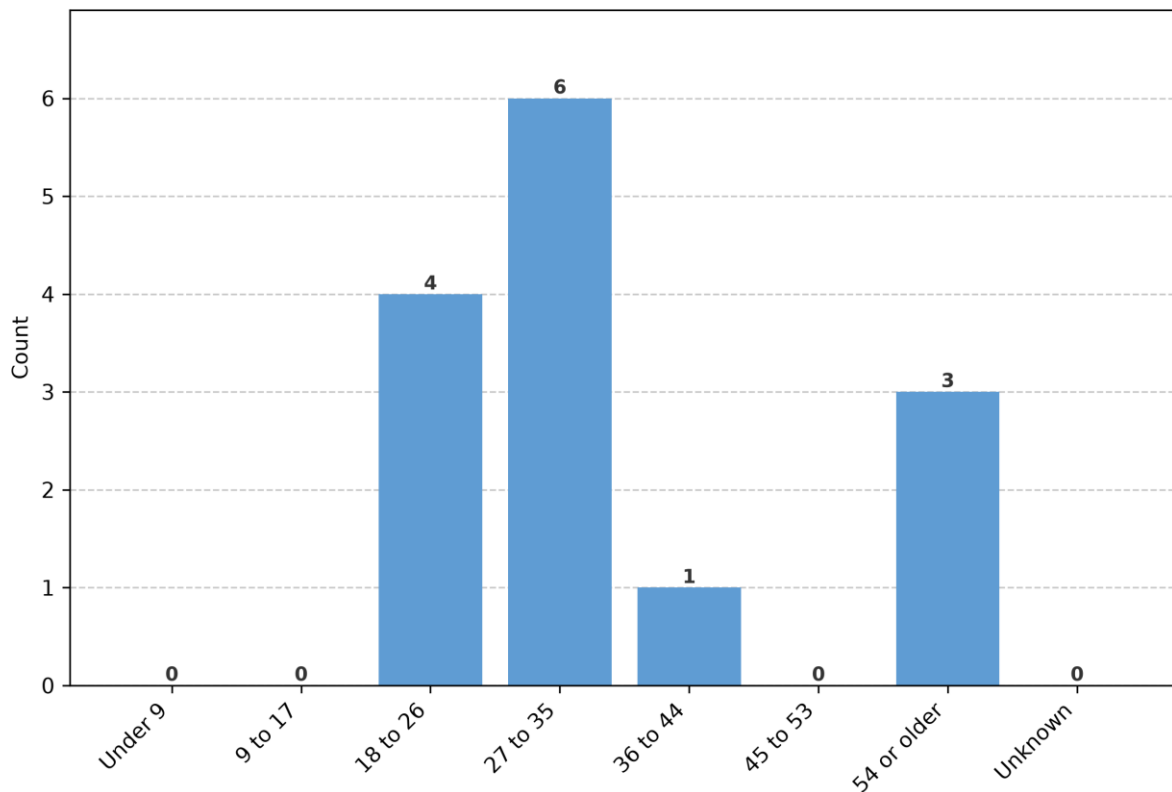
10 of the 14 shooting victims during the week of August 3rd were Black.

The most shooting victims (n:6, 43%) during the week of August 3rd were between the ages of 27 and 35.

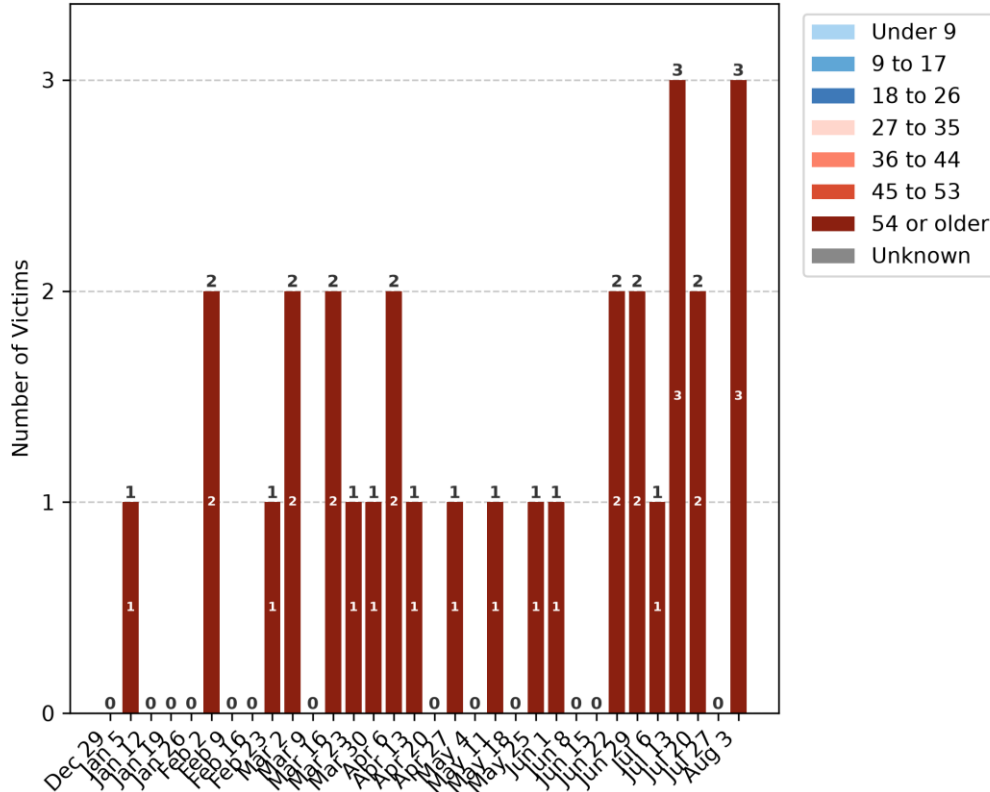
