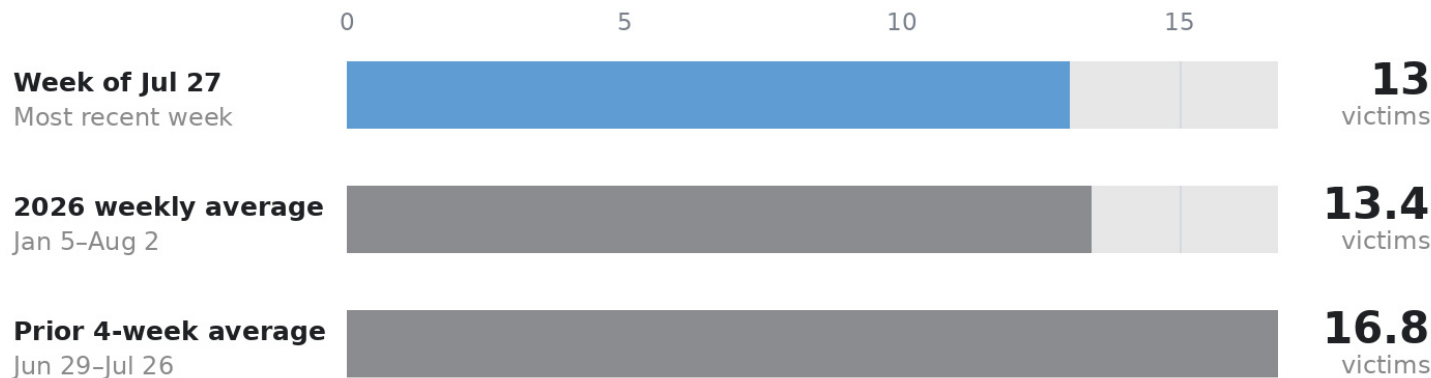

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# Philadelphia Shooting Victims - Latest Week vs. Benchmarks

Week of July 27, 2026 compared with the 2026 and prior 4-week averages



**3% below** the 2026 weekly average

**22% below** the prior 4-week average

- There were 13 shooting victims during the week of July 27<sup>th</sup>.
- For 2026 calendar year to date, there has been an average of 13.4 shooting victims per week.
- In the 4 prior weeks (6/29 – 7/26), there was an average of 16.8 weekly shooting victims.
  - While elevated, this prior-4-week average is down from the 20.5 weekly average from 6/22 – 7/19 due to the 9-victim total the week of July 20<sup>th</sup> (*see last week's shootings report*).
  - The 13 shooting victims for the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> mark a return to yearly average victimization totals, and a continued cooling of violence following early summer surges.

# Key Takeaways

- For the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> – August 2<sup>nd</sup>, across the City of Philadelphia, there were: 12 documented shooting incidents, 13 documented shooting victims, and 4 documented shooting fatalities.
- This week saw a return to more familiar patterns of violence following an early summer surge in shootings and the previous week's low victimization rates and absence of fatal or multi-victim shootings.
  - The 13 shooting victims this week match the average 13.4 weekly victimization rate for calendar year to-date.
  - After the previous week had numerous older victims and incidents stemming from what appeared to be domestic altercations, 4 of 10 incidents with an associated news story this week outlined the shooting of a single victim on the street or in a car with no further indication of motive (with one additional single-victim, no-suggested-motive incident occurring in a home).
  - After a 2-week spike in the percentage of shooting victims over the age of 27, the most shooting victims (31%) for the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> were between the ages of 18 and 26; this matches year-to-date victimization age trends.

# Key Takeaways

- A few neighborhoods remained of particular interest this week and could benefit from additional community supports.
  - The shooting of a 20 y/o Black male on the 4900 Block of Old York Road in the Logan neighborhood of the 19141 ZIP code on 8/1 was the fourth separate shooting incident of a Black male between the ages of 20 and 34 in the approximate 2 blocks from 4900 Old York Road to 4800 N Broad St since July 6<sup>th</sup>.
  - The Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood had multiple shooting incidents for a second consecutive week and sixth of the last eight weeks. Nicetown-Tioga has now accounted for the most shooting victims of any neighborhood this calendar year.
  - The Paschall-Kingsessing neighborhood had 2 fatal shootings this week.
- Delivery drivers remained a target of gun violence this week. The shooting of a delivery driver by an adult male following a confrontation with a teenage girl and adult woman marks the third shooting of a rideshare or delivery driver in July; the fifth since June. A closer look should be given to these incidents to see if there are any strategies that may be employed to break this pattern.

# Key Takeaways

- As of 8/2/26, there were 410 reported shooting victims for calendar year 2026; this marks an approximate 36% decrease from the same timeframe in 2025, when there were 641 reported shooting victims.
  - There was no change in the total between-year victimization gap from the previous week (36%).

# A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- Of the 12 documented shooting incidents, 10 received dedicated coverage on local news outlets (83%). Of these stories:
  - 3 of 10 (30%) describe shootings appearing to stem from an escalation of physical or verbal arguments/fights:
    - A confrontation between a delivery driver, a teenage girl, and an adult woman escalated when the driver was struck in the back of the head and then nonfatally shot by another man while running back to his car.
    - A 34 y/o man was fatally shot 4 times in the upper body by a 24 y/o man with a legally permitted firearm after the two “got into a dispute” during which both men pulled out firearms.
    - A 29 y/o woman was nonfatally shot in the shoulder following “an argument involving an individual who was acting erratically on the street.” News reports indicate the suspect may live on the block.
  - 1 of 10 (10%) describe a block being sprayed with bullets for unknown reasons:
    - A 34 y/o and 38 y/o man were shot when news stories report an unknown shooter fired at least 36 shots; both were hospitalized and in stable condition. No further motive was discussed.

# A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- 1 of 10 (10%) stories include a shooter claiming self-defense.
  - A 43 y/o man was shot nonfatally in the left buttock in a home in the Fern Rock neighborhood by another man who claimed to have shot him in self-defense. No arrests were made as of article publication and no further details provided.
- 5 of 10 (50%) stories outlined single-victim shooting incidents with no indication of a potential motive.
  - A 16 y/o boy was found nonfatally shot in the neck at the PHA Whitehall Apartments. No motive was outlined but a witness claims to have seen a group of young people gathered in the area before hearing the gunshot.
  - A 38 y/o man was found fatally shot multiple times in the torso in the passenger seat of a car; no further details provided.
  - A 53 y/o man was fatally shot once in the back inside a home in Southwest Philadelphia; no further details provided.
  - A 42 y/o man was fatally shot in the street at around 4:20 AM in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood; no further details provided.
  - A 20 y/o woman was nonfatally shot in the arm in the Olney neighborhood. Police discovered her after following and stopping a car that sped away from the scene of the reported shooting; no further details provided.

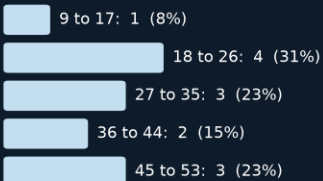

This represents a 3-incident, 4-victim, and 4-fatality increase from the previous week.

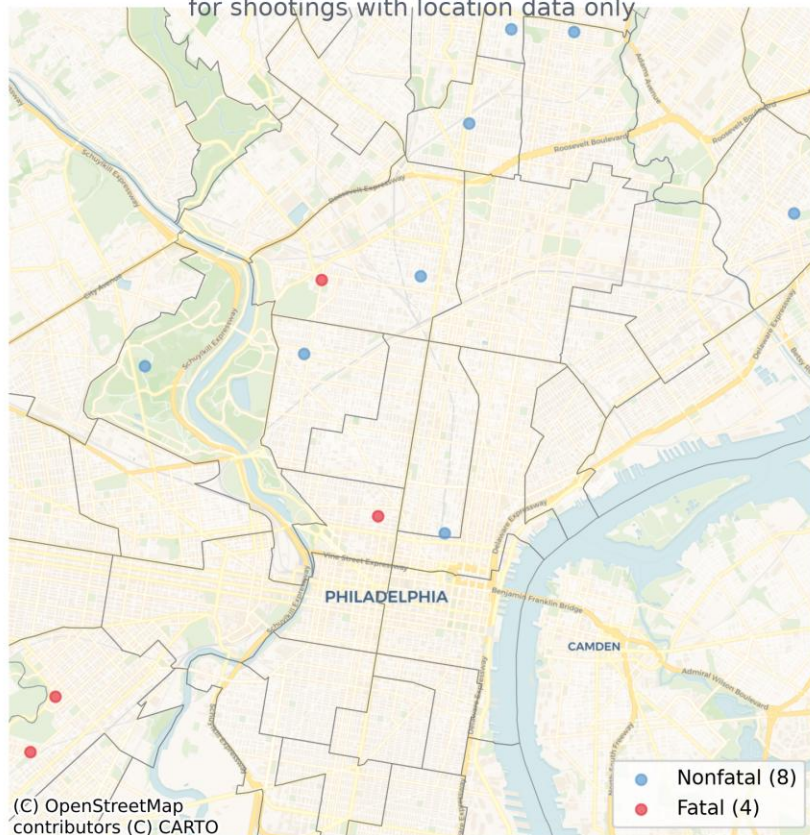

## Shooting Incidents - Map

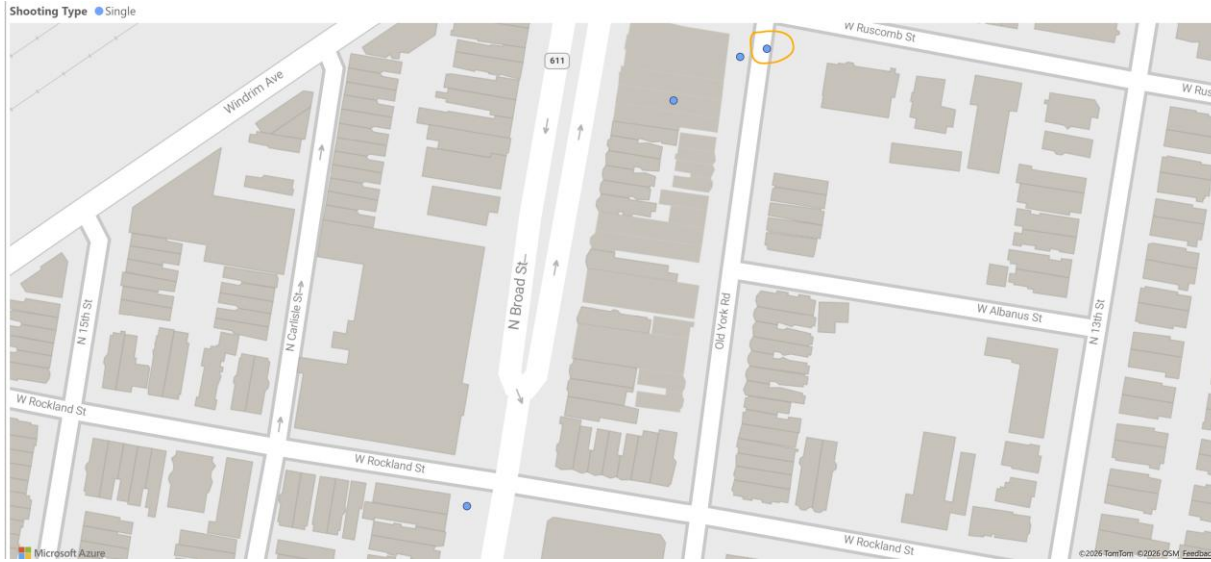

# A Closer Look: 4800/4900 Blocks in Logan



On Saturday, 8/1, at 5:55 AM, a 20 y/o Black male was nonfatally shot on the 4900 Block of Old York Road in the Logan neighborhood of the 19141 ZIP code (circled).

This marks the fourth Black male between the ages of 20 and 34 shot in separate shooting incidents in the approximate 2 blocks from 4900 Old York Road to 4800 N Broad St since July 6<sup>th</sup>.

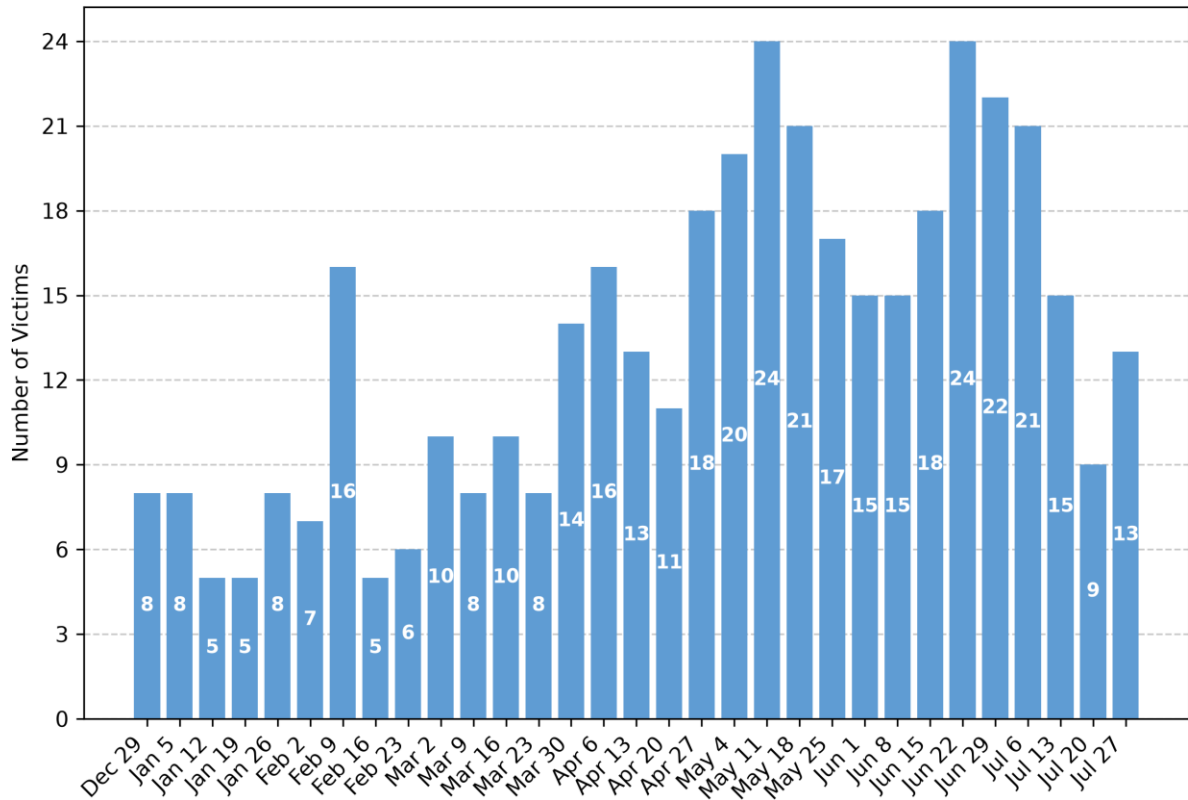
Only 1 of these shootings has had an associated news story – what appeared to be a targeted robbery inside a deli. These blocks could likely benefit from additional community supports.

ALL\_ZIPS, January 1, 2026 to August 2, 2026



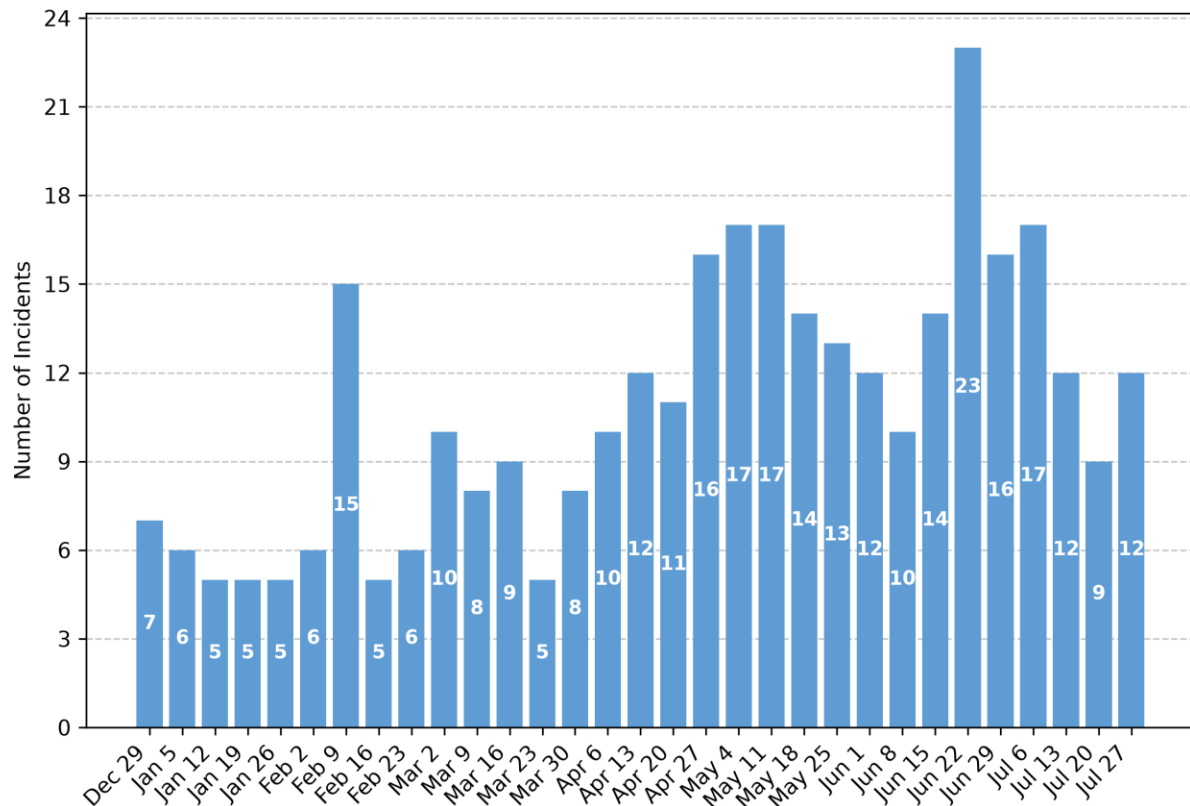
The week of July 27<sup>th</sup> saw a 4-victim increase in the number of total reported shooting victims (13) from the previous week (9).

Following a 4-week period of escalated violence (weeks of 6/15 – 7/6) and last week's substantial drop, the 13 shooting victims this week marked a return to average weekly victimization totals for calendar year 2026 (13.4).



## Total Shooting Incidents - By Week (#)

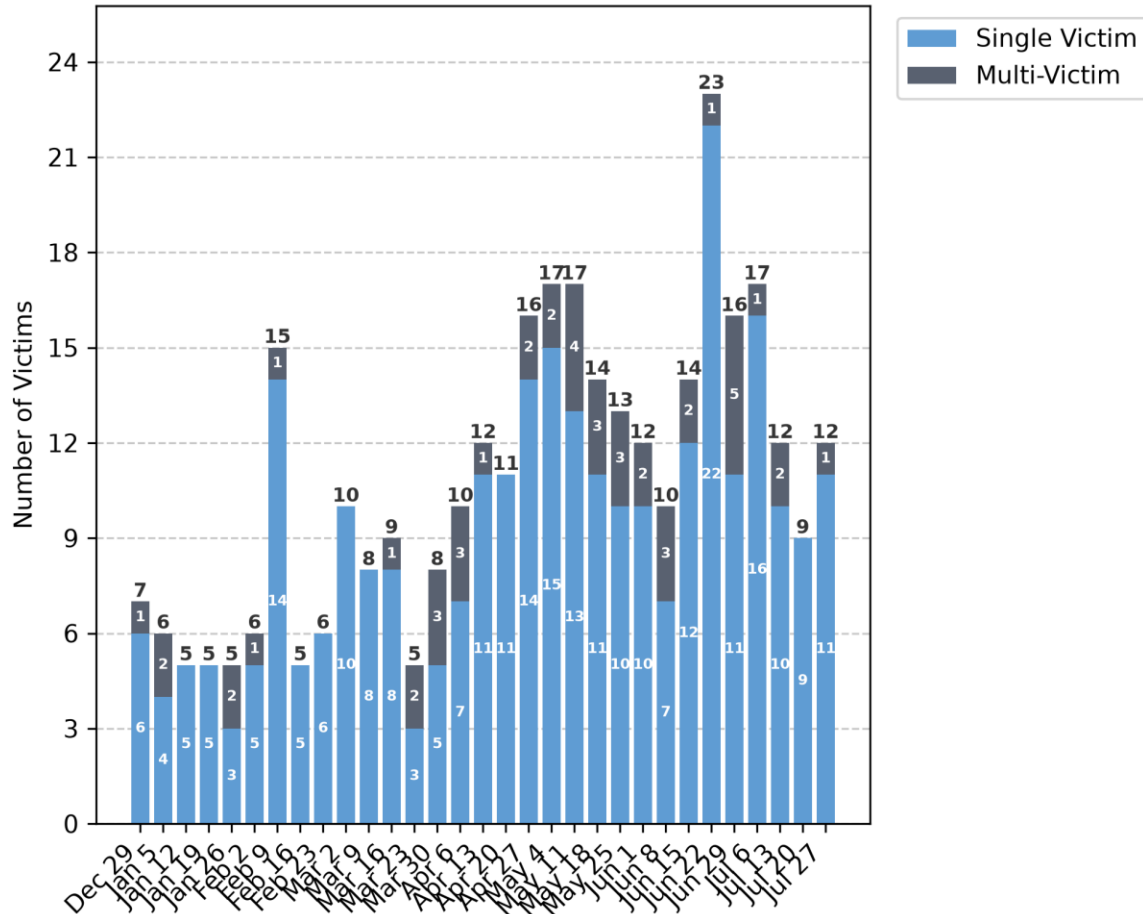

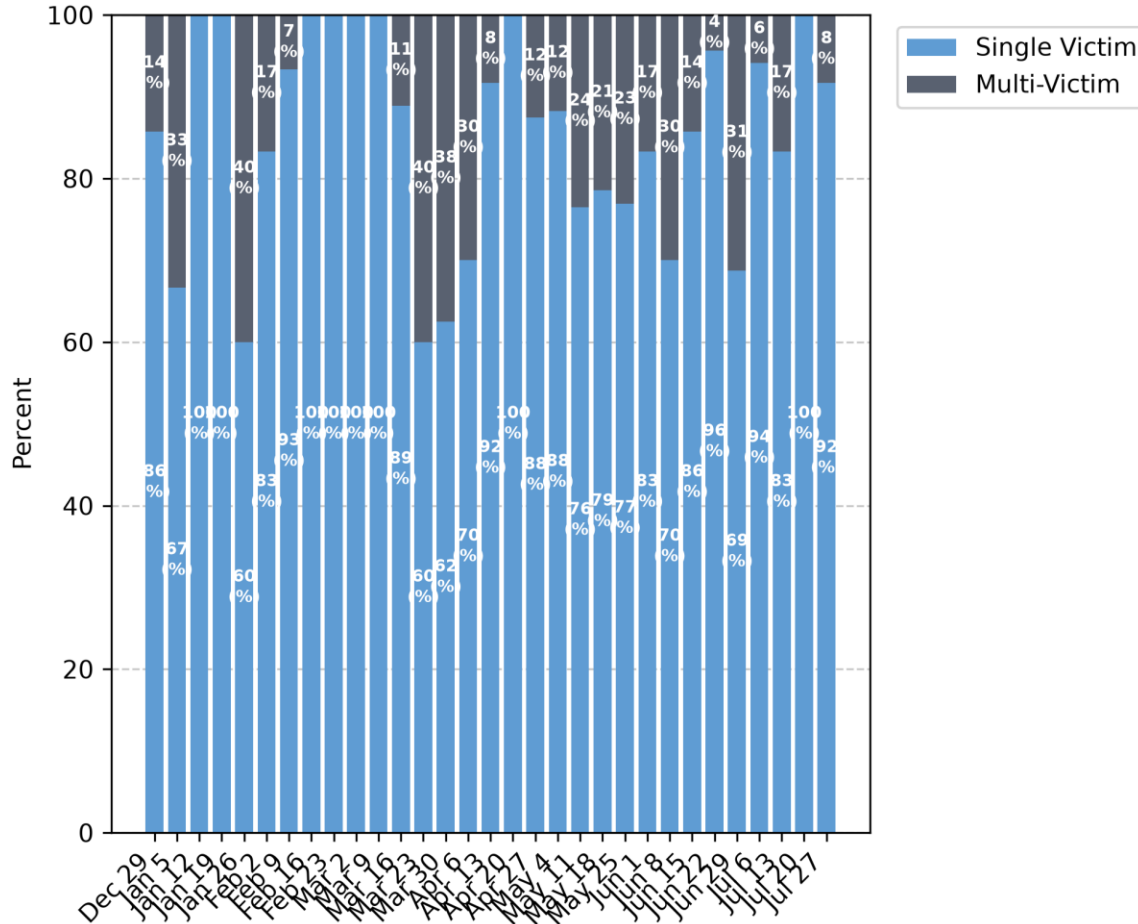


The 13 total shooting victims during the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> were the result of 12 individual shooting incidents.

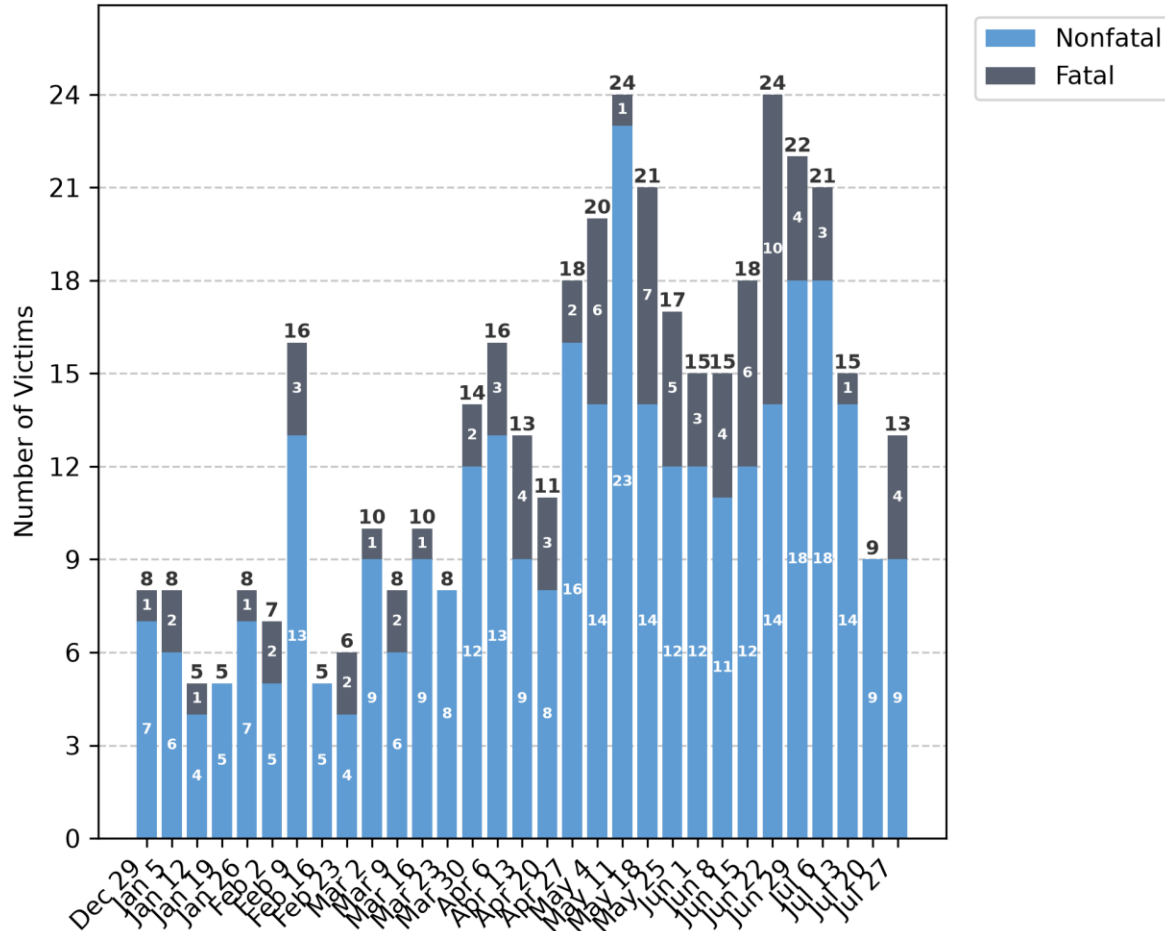

  - On Monday, 7/27, at 12:26 AM, on the 2900 Block of W Gordon St in the Strawberry Mansion neighborhood of the 19132 ZIP code, public data indicates that a 38 y/o and 34 y/o man were shot after an unknown shooter fired at least 36 shots. 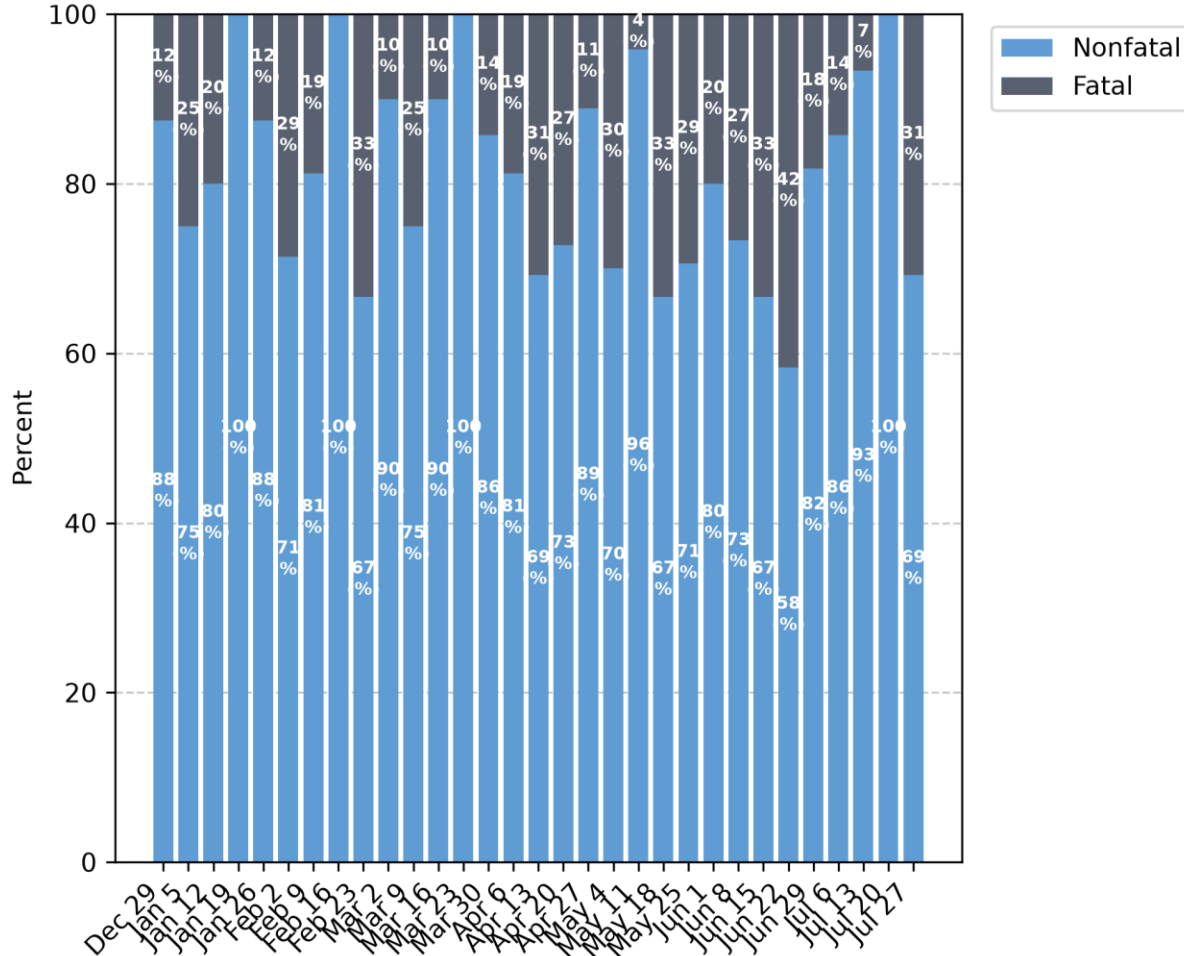

- There were 4 fatal shootings in the public data for the week of July 27<sup>th</sup>.
  - All 4 fatal shooting victims were Black males.
  - 2 of the 4 fatalities this week took place in the Paschall-Kingsessing neighborhood.
  - All fatal shootings occurred between the hours of 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM.

# A Closer Look at Fatal Shootings

- On Wednesday, 7/29, at 11:14 PM, on the 1600 Block of Wallace St in the Fairmount-Spring Garden neighborhood of the 19130 ZIP code, a 34 y/o man was fatally shot 4 times in the upper body by a 24 y/o man with a legally permitted firearm after the two “got into a dispute” during which both men pulled out firearms. "Police said the 24-year-old has a valid permit to carry and told investigators the older man was allegedly intoxicated."

- On Thursday, 7/30, at 12:01 AM, on the 5900 Block of Warrington Ave in the Paschall-Kingssessing neighborhood of the 19143 ZIP code, a 38 y/o man was found in the front passenger seat of a car after having been shot multiple times in the torso. He was rushed to a hospital where he was pronounced dead. News articles report that at least 5 shots were fired through the driver's side door. There were no further details provided.

# A Closer Look at Fatal Shootings

- On Saturday, 8/1, at 5:44 AM, on the 6500 Block of Regent St in the Paschall-Kingssessing neighborhood of the 19142 ZIP code, a 53 y/o man was shot once in the back inside of a home in Southwest Philadelphia. He died on the scene. Police did not release any information about a possible motive.

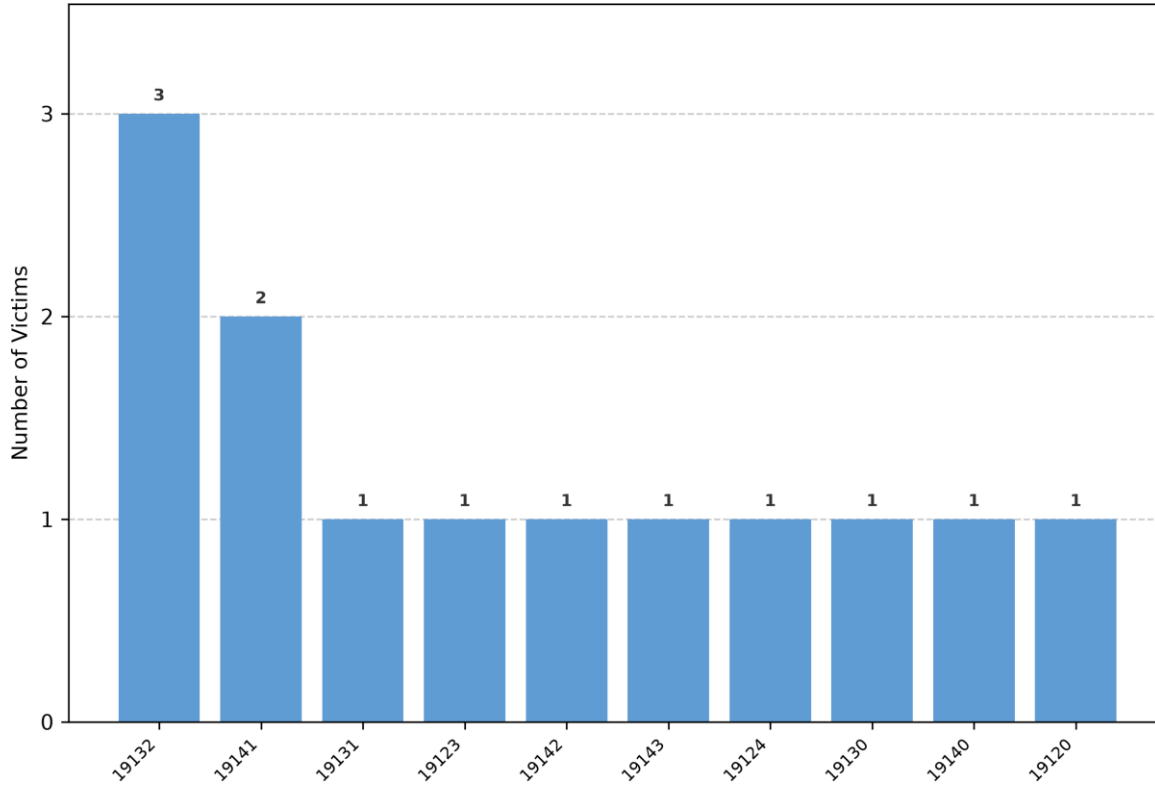
- On Sunday, 8/2, at 4:20 AM, on the 3100 Block of N 29<sup>th</sup> St in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood of the 19132 ZIP code, police were called to the block and found a 42 y/o man shot multiple times. There were at least 7 shell casings found on the scene. The man was taken to Temple University Hospital where he was pronounced. No weapon was found on the scene and no motive was discussed in news stories.

The 19141 ZIP code also had multiple shooting victims.

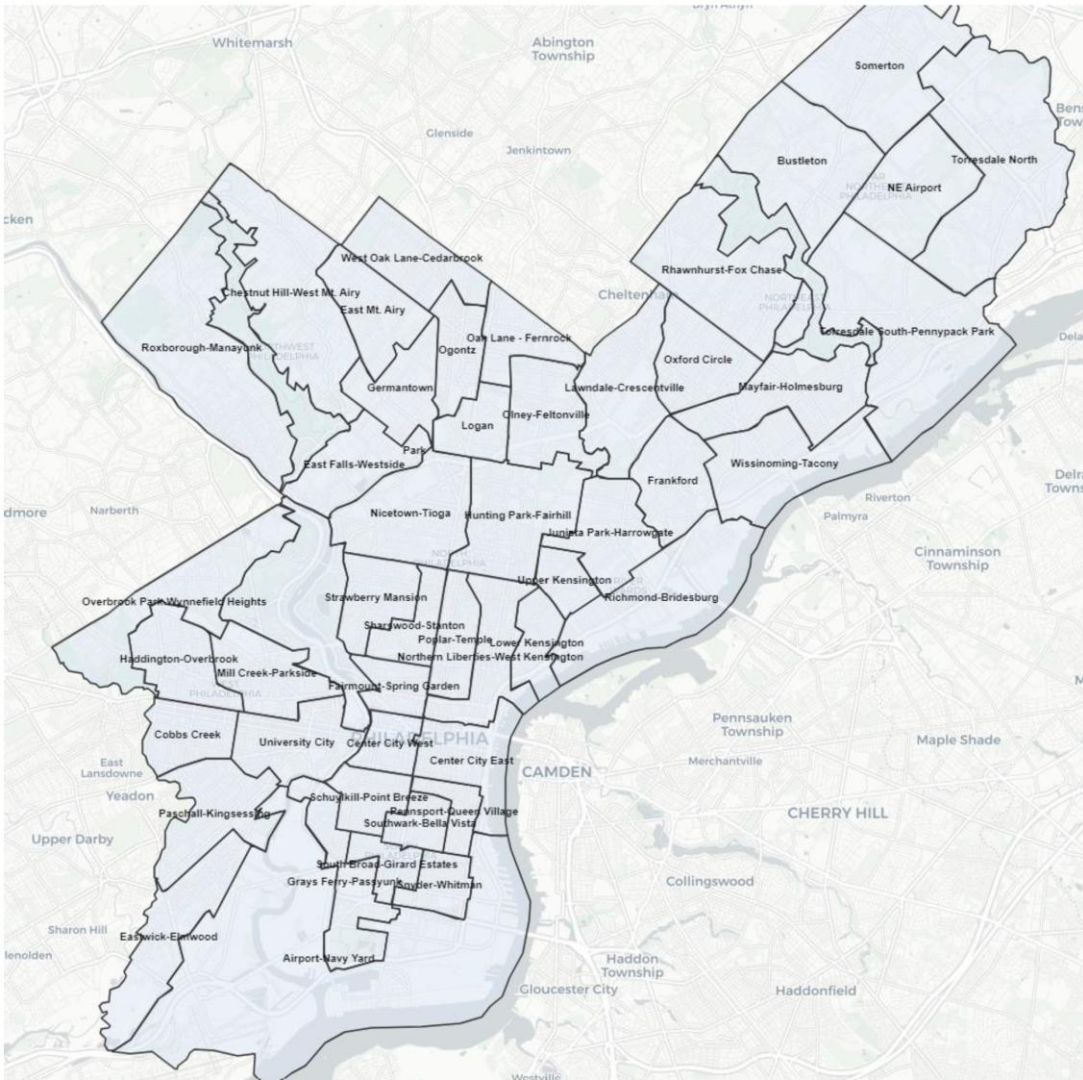

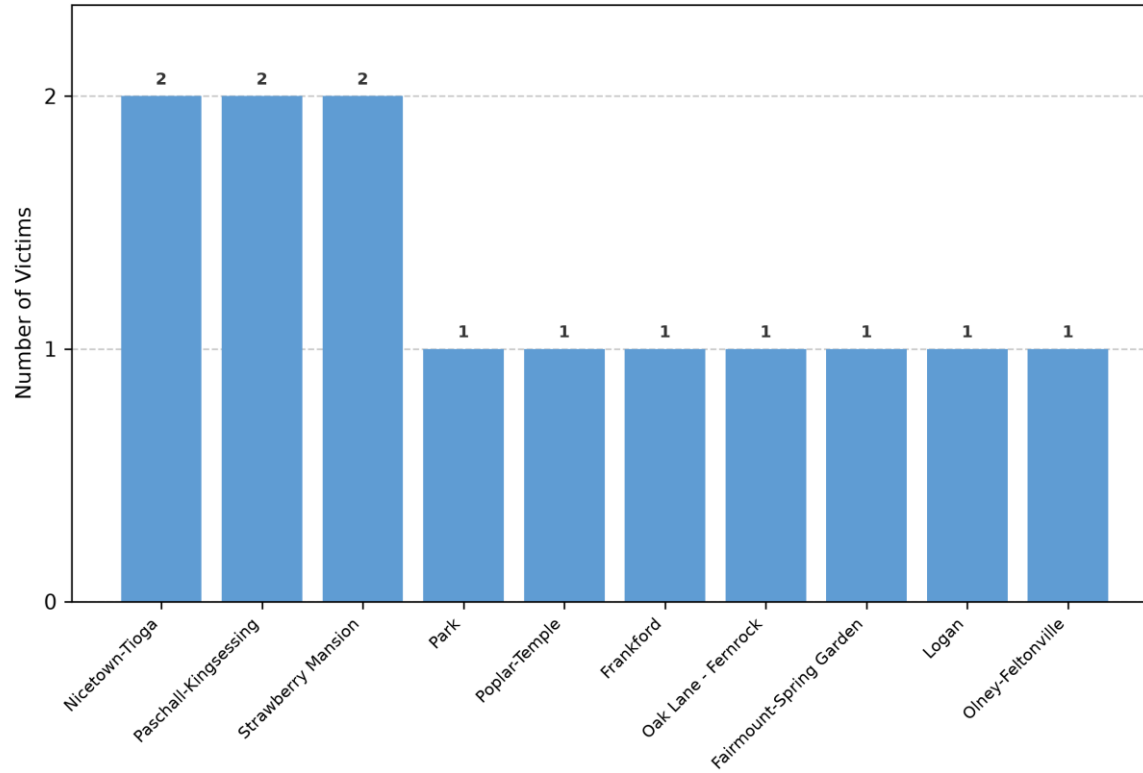

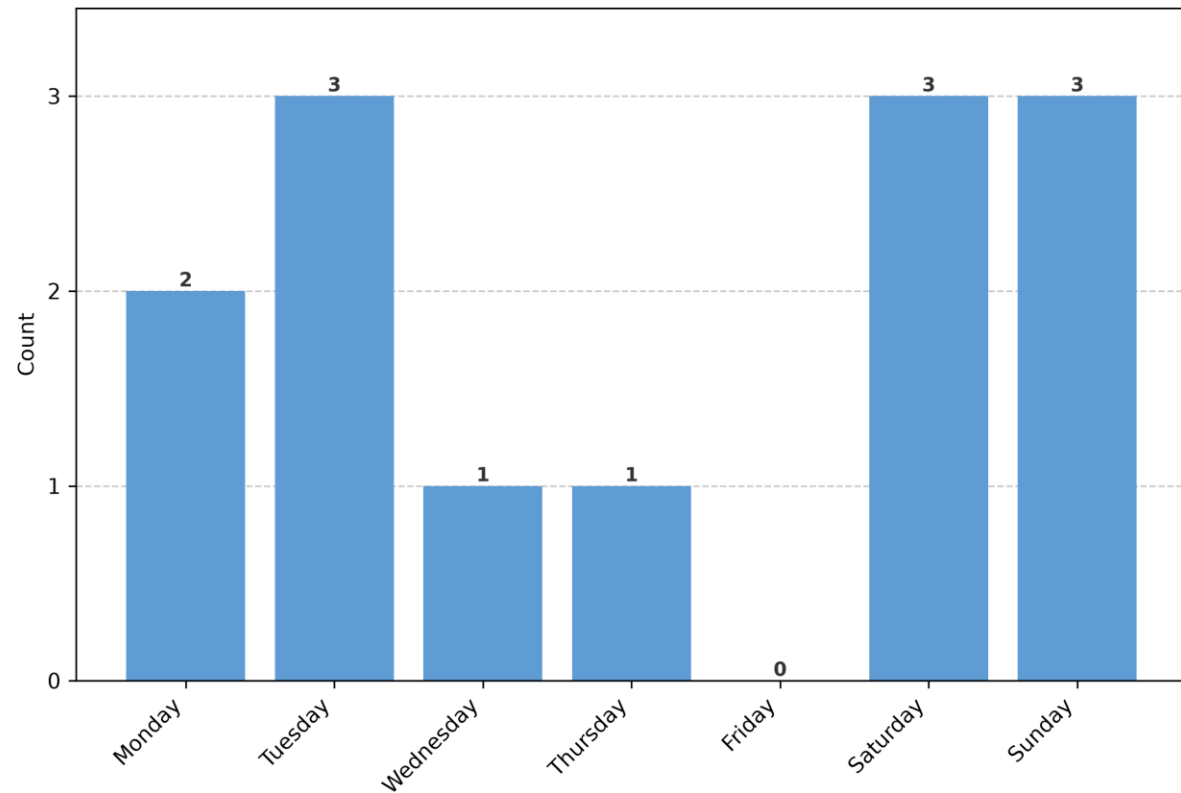

There were no shootings in the City of Philadelphia on Friday, 7/31.

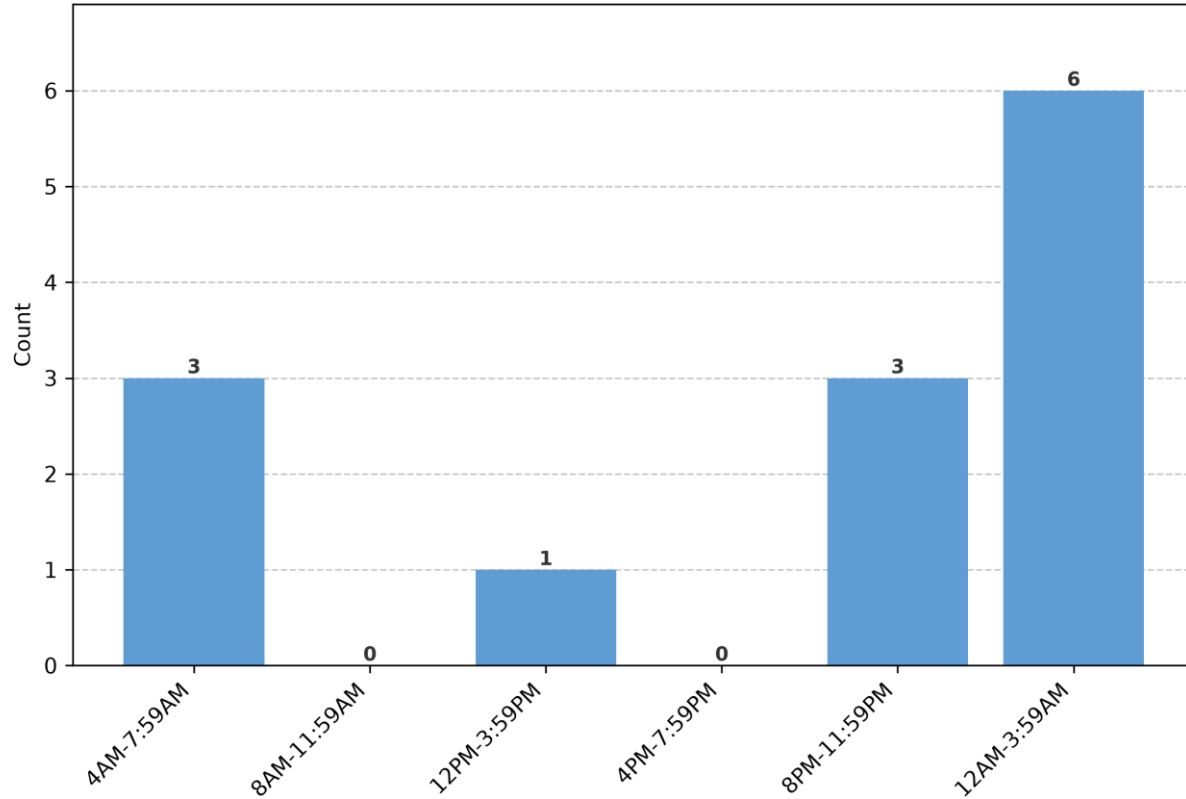
6 of 13 shooting victims (46%) were shot on Saturday or Sunday.

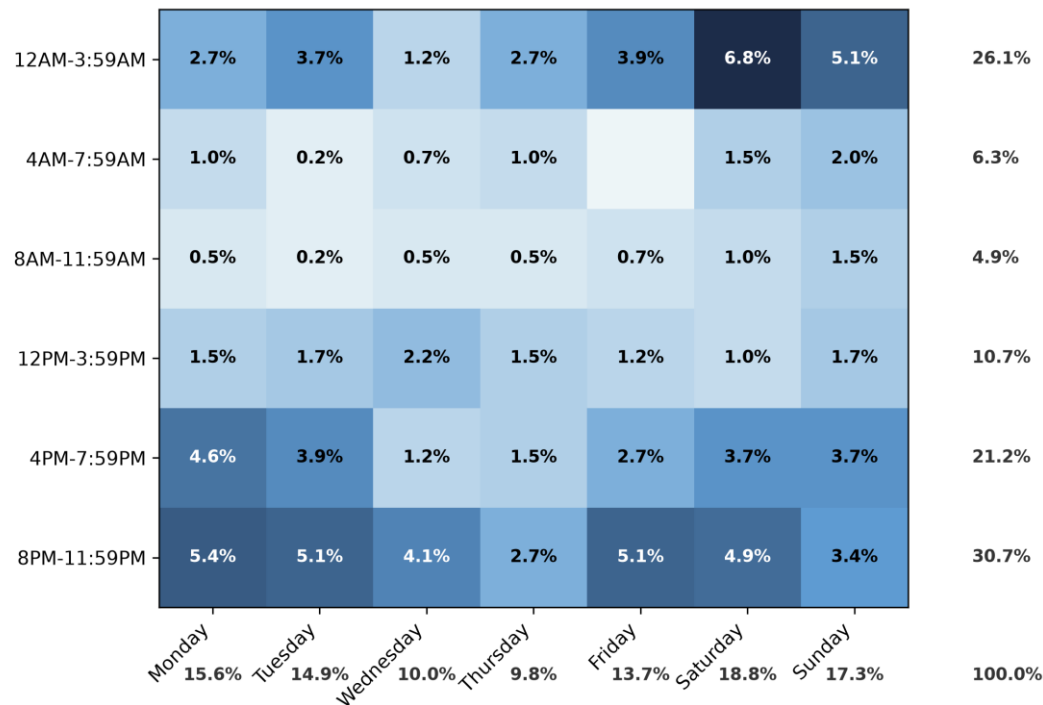


The most victims (n:6, 46%) were shot between the hours of 12:00 AM and 3:59 AM.

For the calendar year, the most victims have been shot on a Saturday (18.8%) or Sunday (17.3%).

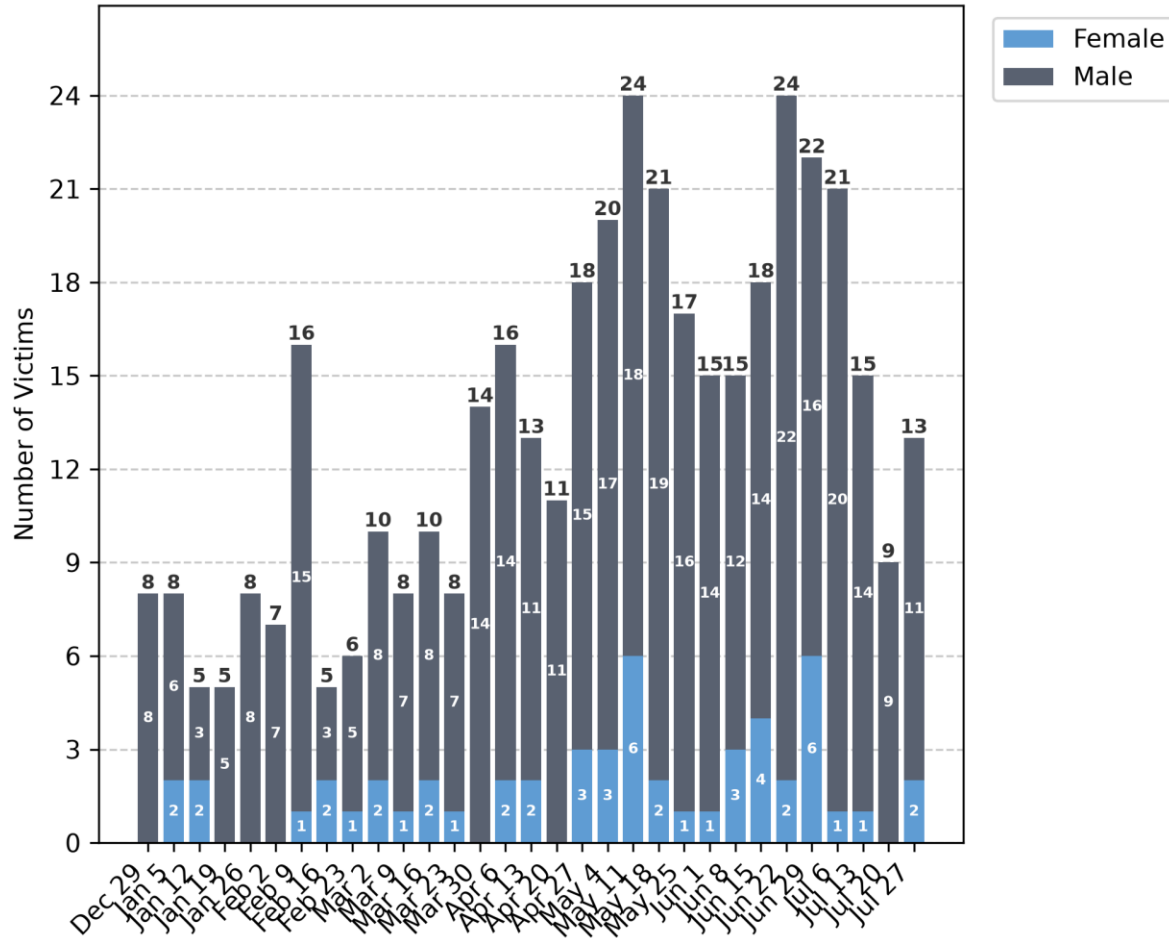
The most victims have been shot in the 8:00 PM – 11:59 PM window (30.7%).

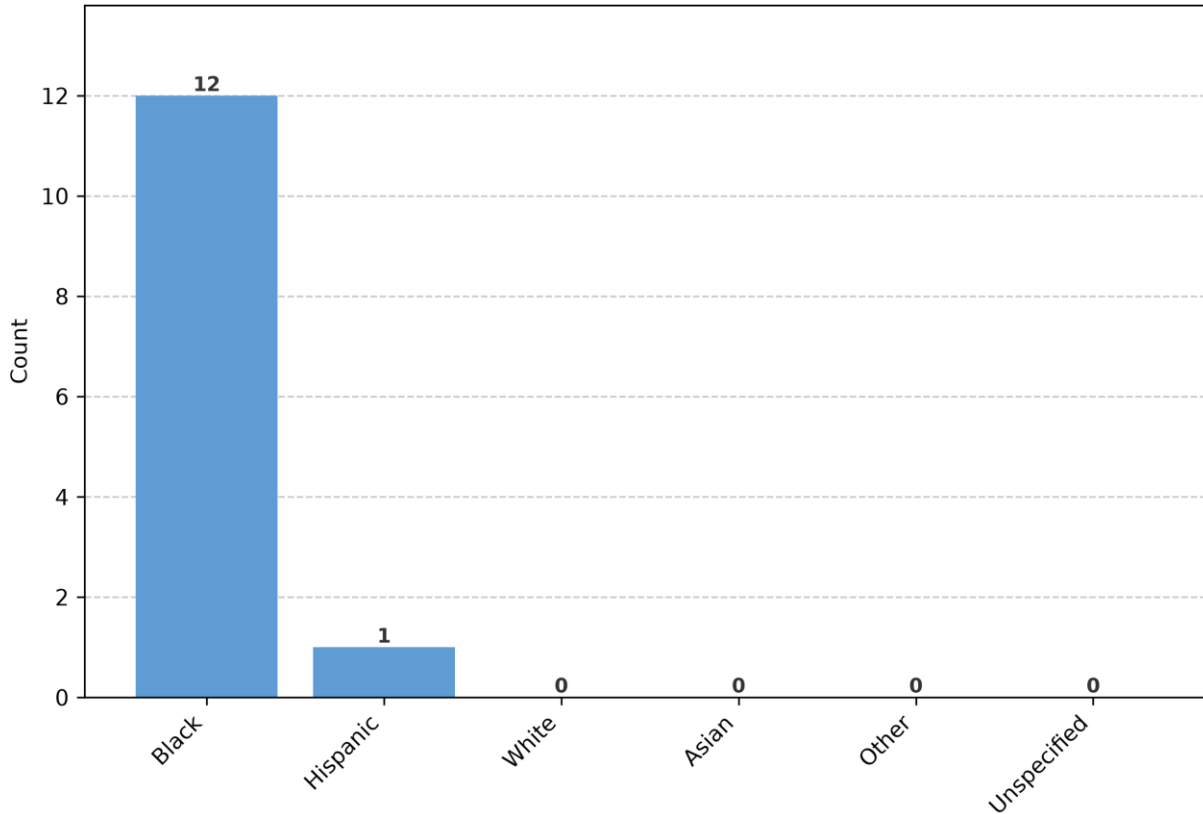


11 of 13 shooting victims (85%) during the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> were male.

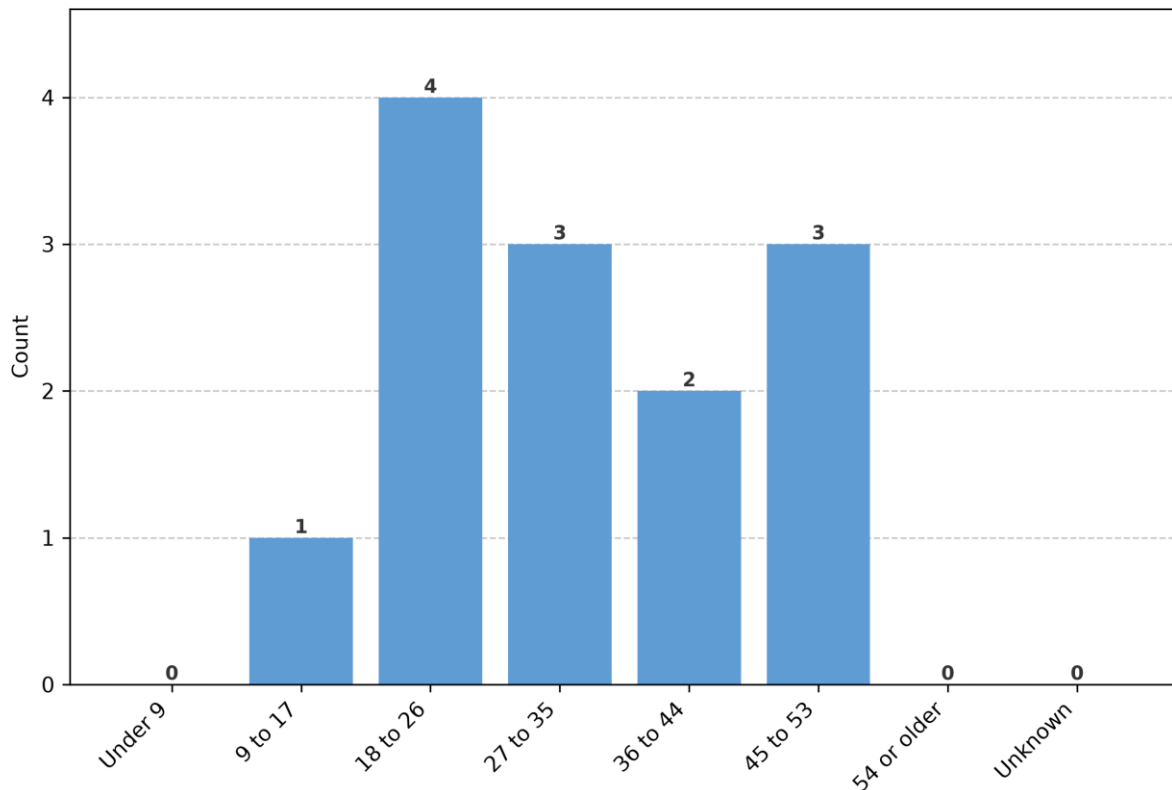
12 of the 13 shooting victims during the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> were Black.

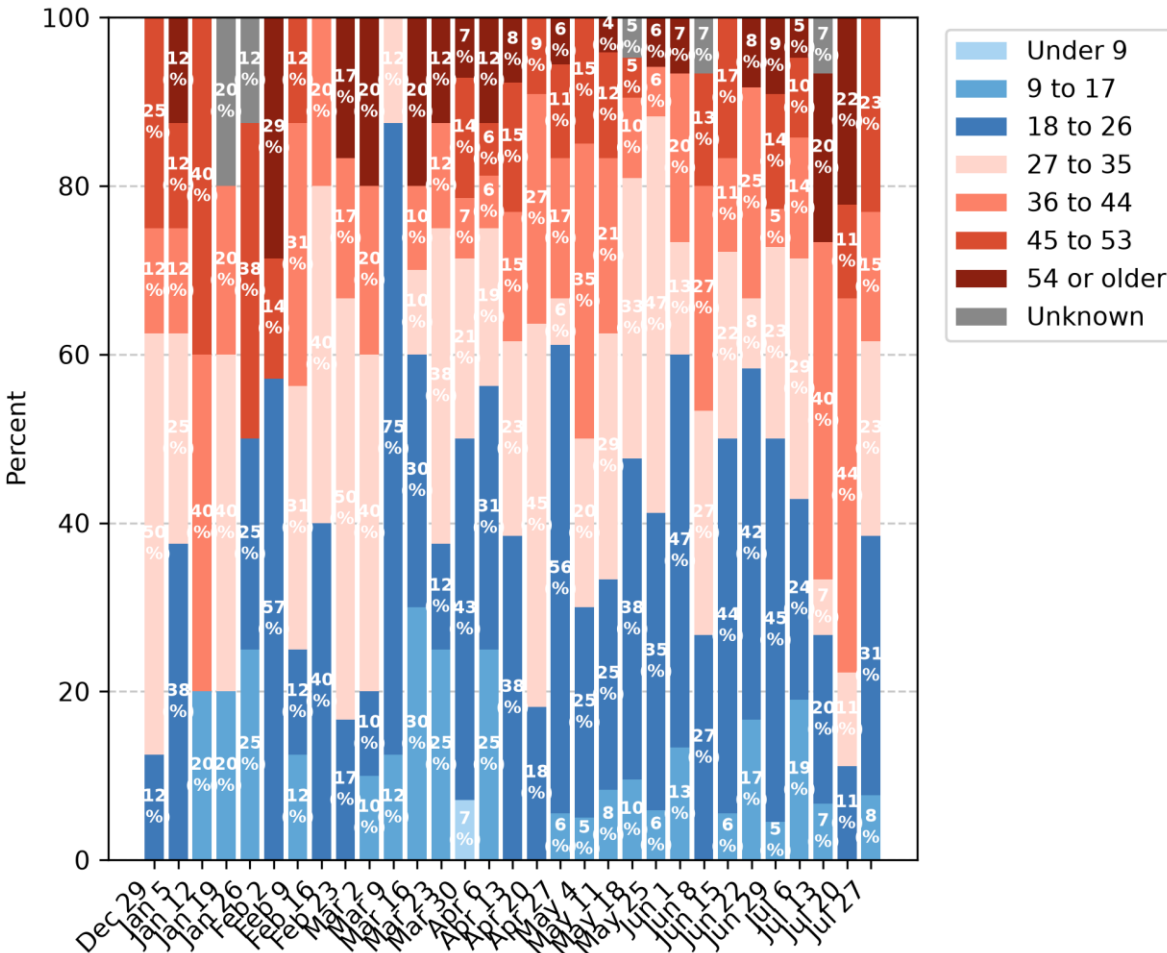

- There was 1 youth shooting victim for the week of July 27<sup>th</sup>.
  - On Tuesday, 7/28, at 1:33 PM, on the 4700 Block of Tackawanna PL in the Frankford neighborhood of the 19124 ZIP code, a 16-year-old Hispanic male was nonfatally shot in the neck. News stories indicate this shooting occurred at the PHA Whitehall Apartments. Police allegedly found 1 spent shell casing and took an electric scooter into evidence. After a 2-week spike in the percentage of shooting victims over the age of 27, the most shooting victims (31%) for the week of July 27<sup>th</sup> were between the ages of 18 and 26, mirroring year-to-date trends.

For the calendar year to date (as of August 2<sup>nd</sup>), approximately 32% of shooting victims have been between the ages of 18 and 26; approximately 10% have been below 18 years of age.
