

Philadelphia Shootings Trend Report: All Areas

Key Takeaways

- For the week of June 22nd – June 28th, across the City of Philadelphia, there were: 23 documented shooting incidents, 24 documented shooting victims, and 9 documented shooting fatalities.
 - This represents a 9-incident increase, 6-victim increase, and 3-fatality increase from the previous week.
 - Of note, there were an additional 3 shooting victims found in news stories that were not included in the public dataset: 2 non-fatal, and 1 fatal.
- As of 6/28/26, there were 330 reported shooting victims for calendar year 2026; this marks a 34% decrease from the same timeframe in 2025, when there were 503 reported shooting victims.
 - This week saw a 3% loss in year-to-date violence reduction gains, with the 2025 to 2026 gap closing from 37% to 34%.

Key Takeaways

- The week of June 22nd was the most active week of gun violence in Philadelphia for the calendar year.
 - The 24 total shooting victims are equal only to the week of May 11th, while the 23 individual documented incidents are substantially higher than the 17 incidents for the week of May 11th (+35%).
 - The 9 shooting fatalities are also the most of any week this calendar year; the 38% victim fatality rate was the highest for the calendar year.
 - This marks a 2-week escalation of gun violence following a 4-week de-escalation from previous May 11th highs.
- The 4 youth under the age of 18 shot during the week of June 22nd were the most of any single week this calendar year (along with the week of April 6th). News stories indicate that 3 of the 4 youth shooting incidents may have been related to escalating fights.

Key Takeaways

- The most shootings this week occurred in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood (5). There have been multiple shooting victims in Nicetown-Tioga in each of the last 3 weeks. These shootings have accounted for 12 victims and 3 fatalities since Monday, June 8th.
 - The Hunting Park-Fairhill neighborhood has now seen at least 1 shooting victim in 7 of the last 8 weeks.
 - There were no shootings in Strawberry Mansion for the first week of the last 5.

A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- Of the 23 individual shooting incidents, 20 received dedicated coverage on local news outlets. Of these news stories:
 - 5 of 20 (25%) indicated that a shooting happened following a physical or verbal altercation.
 - 3 involved a victim getting shot by an acquaintance – 1 man was shot by a neighbor while sitting in his car, 1 youth was shot by 2 other youth with whom he had been riding e-bikes or scooters, and 1 male bar employee was shot by a co-worker after arguing over closing duties.
 - For the third consecutive week, a shooting was related in some way to parking – in this instance, a man was shot while sitting in a parked car with his girlfriend after returning to a spot where the suspect had previously allegedly told him he wasn't allowed to park.
 - 1 incident was suspected to have stemmed from an argument when a man was shot in his car in front of Lonnie Young Recreation Center; a witness described hearing an argument before gunshots.
 - An additional 2 shootings (10%) involved teenagers shot within blocks and hours of one another with police investigating if the incidents may be related to a fight that happened on a playground earlier that day.

A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- 5 of 20 (25%) stories named circumstances that would indicate a shooting may be targeted or retaliatory.
 - 1 man was ambushed and shot by 3 other men after a confrontation when he was returning to the lawn of a home in Mayfair.
 - 1 man was approached by another man (who exited a car) after leaving a convenience store where he was playing a gambling machine – he was shot after producing a firearm during an argument.
 - 1 man was ambushed by another man and fatally shot in the head on the sidewalk nearby St. James School.
 - 1 man was found shot in the chest near 12th and Hunting Park in circumstances similar to a shooting from the previous week in the same location.
 - 1 man was shot and killed after 2 suspects pulled up beside his car while driving on Frankford Ave and opened fire.
- 2 of 20 (10%) indicated a shooting was likely the result of a robbery.
 - 1 man was shot in the pinky during an attempted robbery; 1 man was shot in the car with a woman and kids present after driving to Philadelphia from New Jersey to purchase a phone from Facebook marketplace.

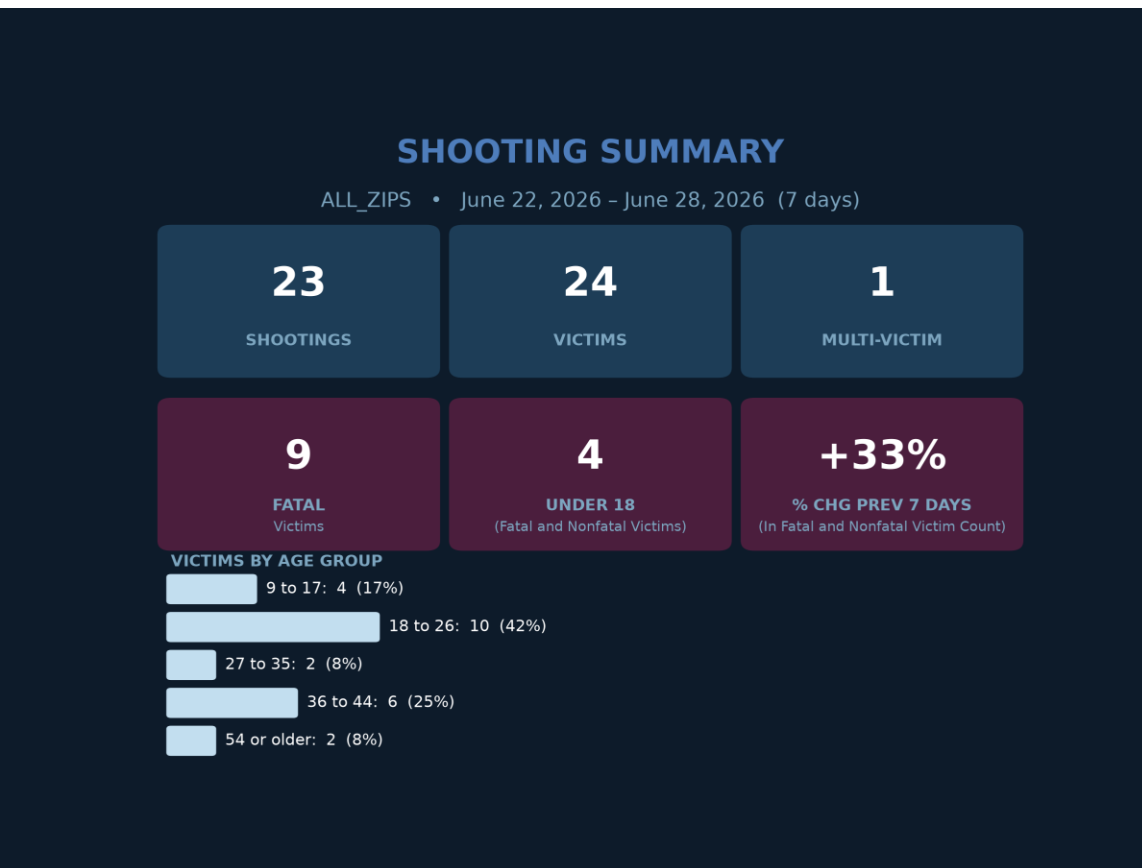
A Closer Look: Shooting Incidents in the News

- 1 of 20 (5%) involved circumstances that appeared accidental.
 - A 16-year-old was shot in the cheek after handling guns in the basement of a house with other teens.
- 1 of 20 (5%) was a murder-suicide.
 - 3 women were found dead when a 67-year-old woman shot and killed an 18-year-old relative and another woman (unknown relation) and then killed herself.
- 4 of 20 (20%) shootings had truly unknown circumstances.
 - 1 man was found non-fatally shot on the 6300 block of Greenway Ave with no further details provided; 1 man was found non-fatally shot on the 2600 block on N Chadwick with other details provided; 1 man was found non-fatally shot multiple times in his apartment with no other details provided; 1 man was found laying on the street on the 3000 Block on N 26th St with no other details provided.

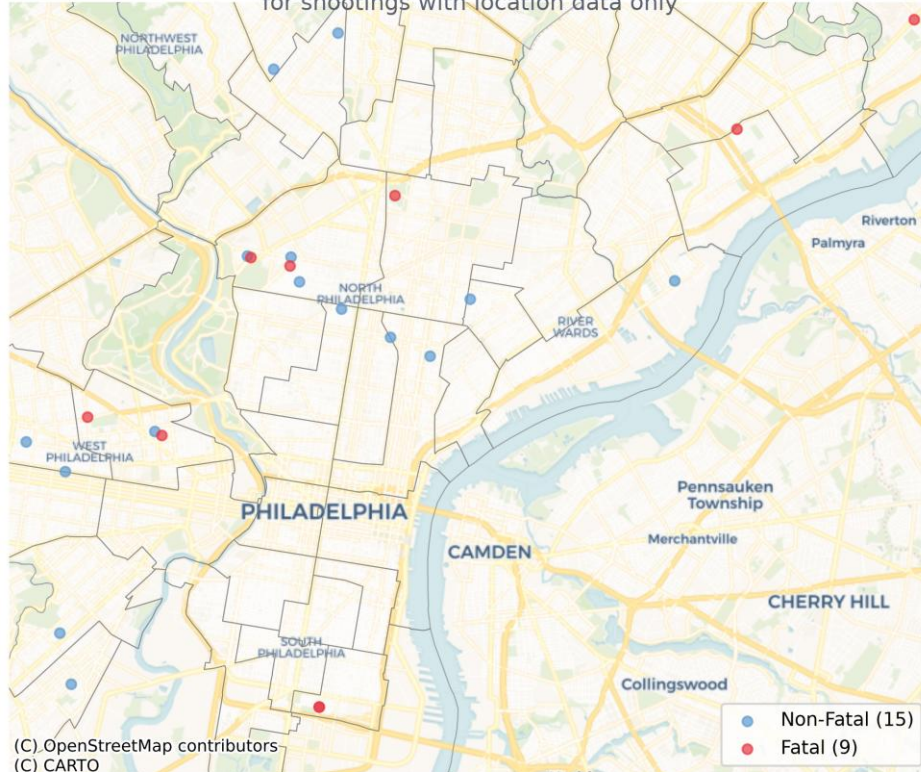
For the week of June 22nd – June 28th, across the City of Philadelphia, public data indicates there were:

- 23 shooting incidents
- 24 shooting victims
- 9 shooting fatalities

This represents a 9-incident increase, 6-victim increase, and 3-fatality increase from the previous week (when there were 14 shooting incidents, 18 total victims, and 6 fatalities).

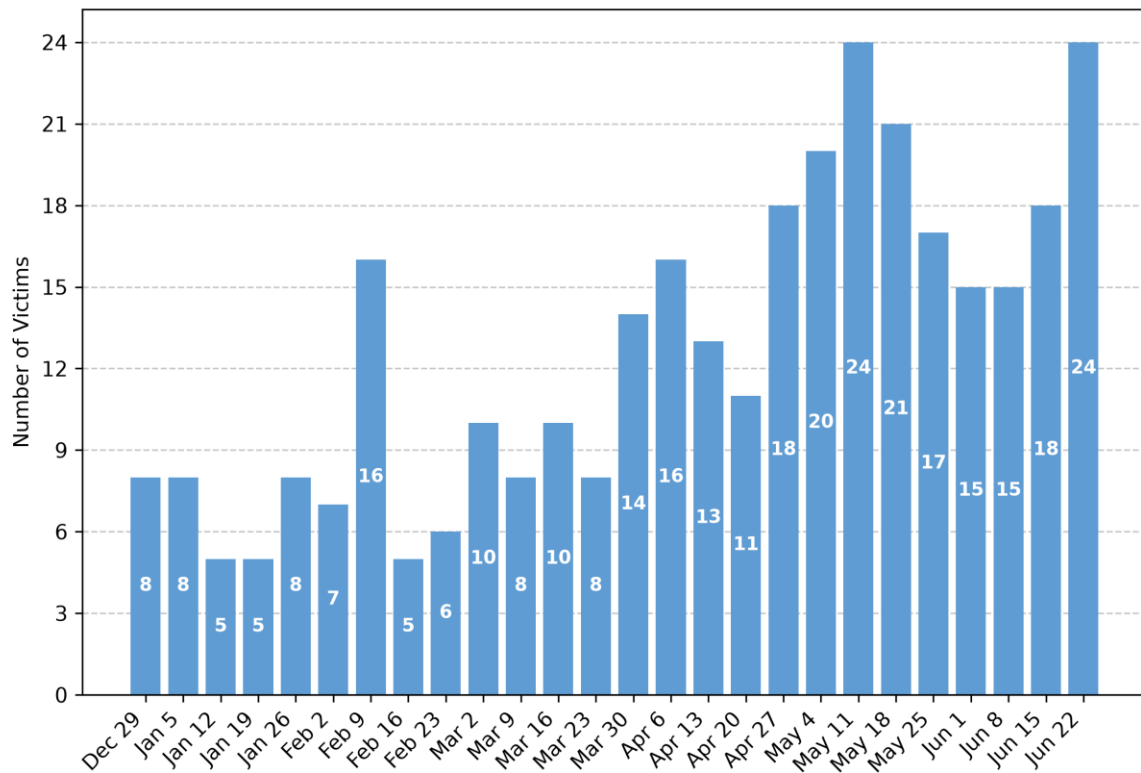

 - On Sunday, 6/28, at 5:30 PM, on the 800 Block of S 60th St in the Cobbs Creek neighborhood of the 19143 ZIP code, a 19-year-old male accidentally shot himself in the hand with a gun in his backpack on a SEPTA bus. He was arrested for a firearms offense after being taken to the hospital.

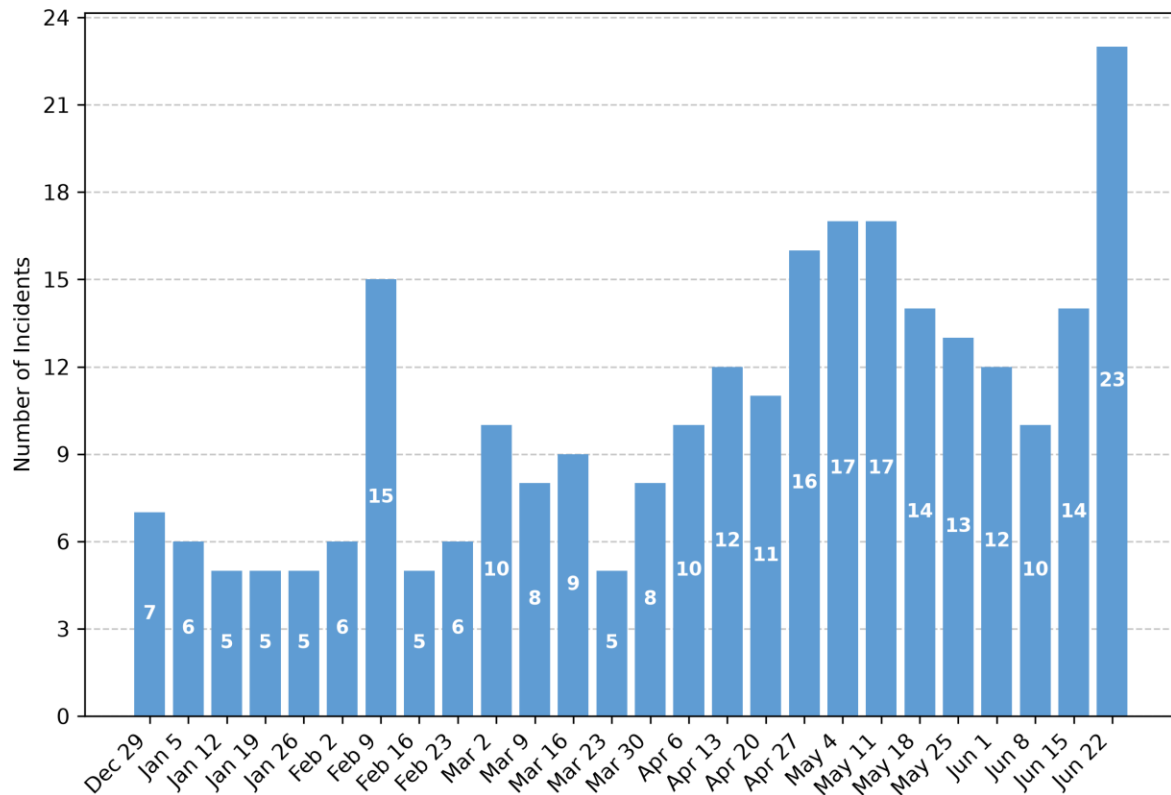


The week of June 22nd saw a 33% uptick in the number of total shooting victims (24) from the previous week (18).

After a 4-week trend of de-escalating shooting victimization, this marks a 2-week escalation, with a return to the calendar year peak of 24 shooting victims (last seen during the week of May 11th).

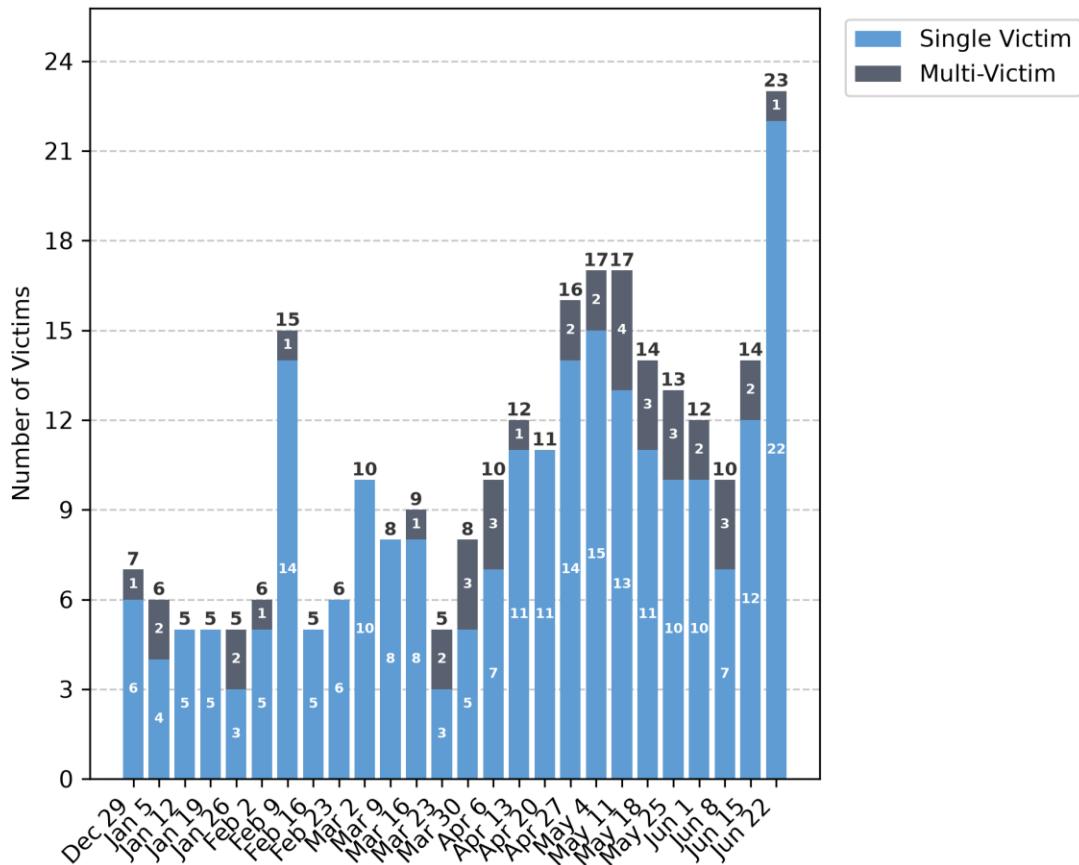


The 23 individual shooting incidents during the week of June 22nd were the most of the calendar year.

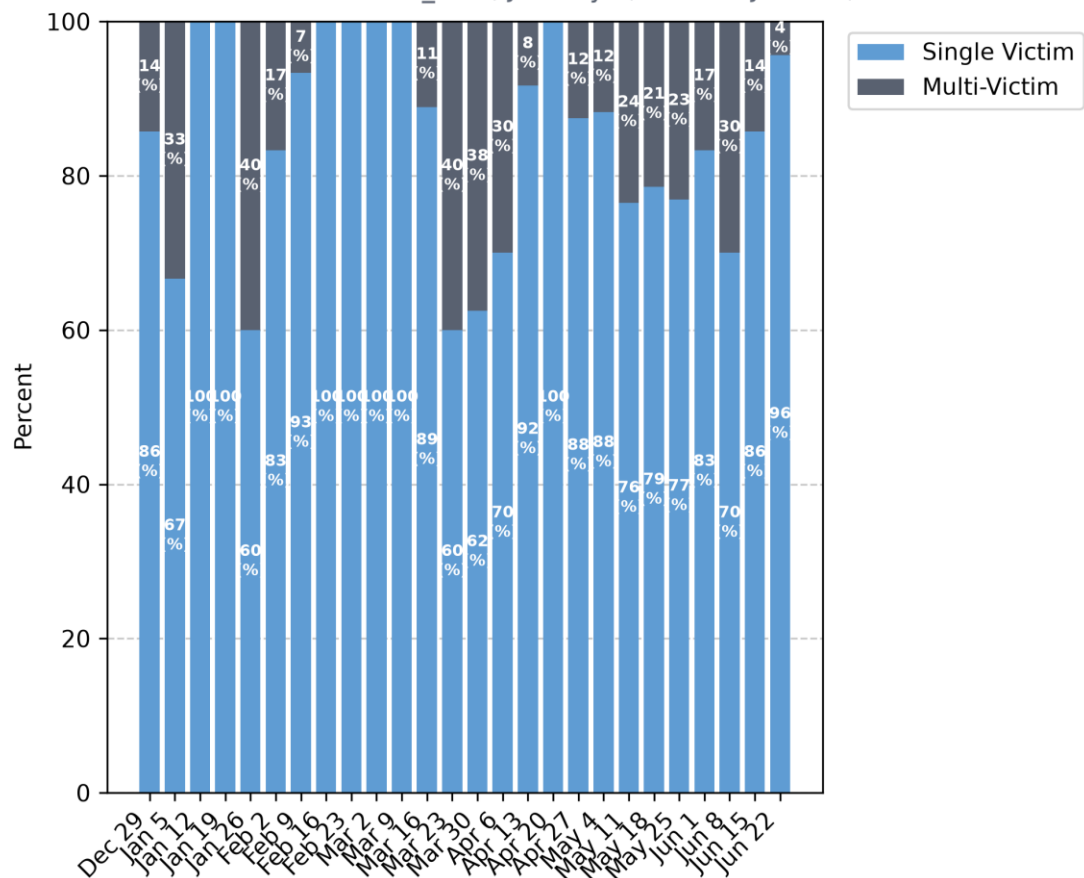


The 24 total shooting victims during the week of June 22nd were the result of 23 shooting incidents.

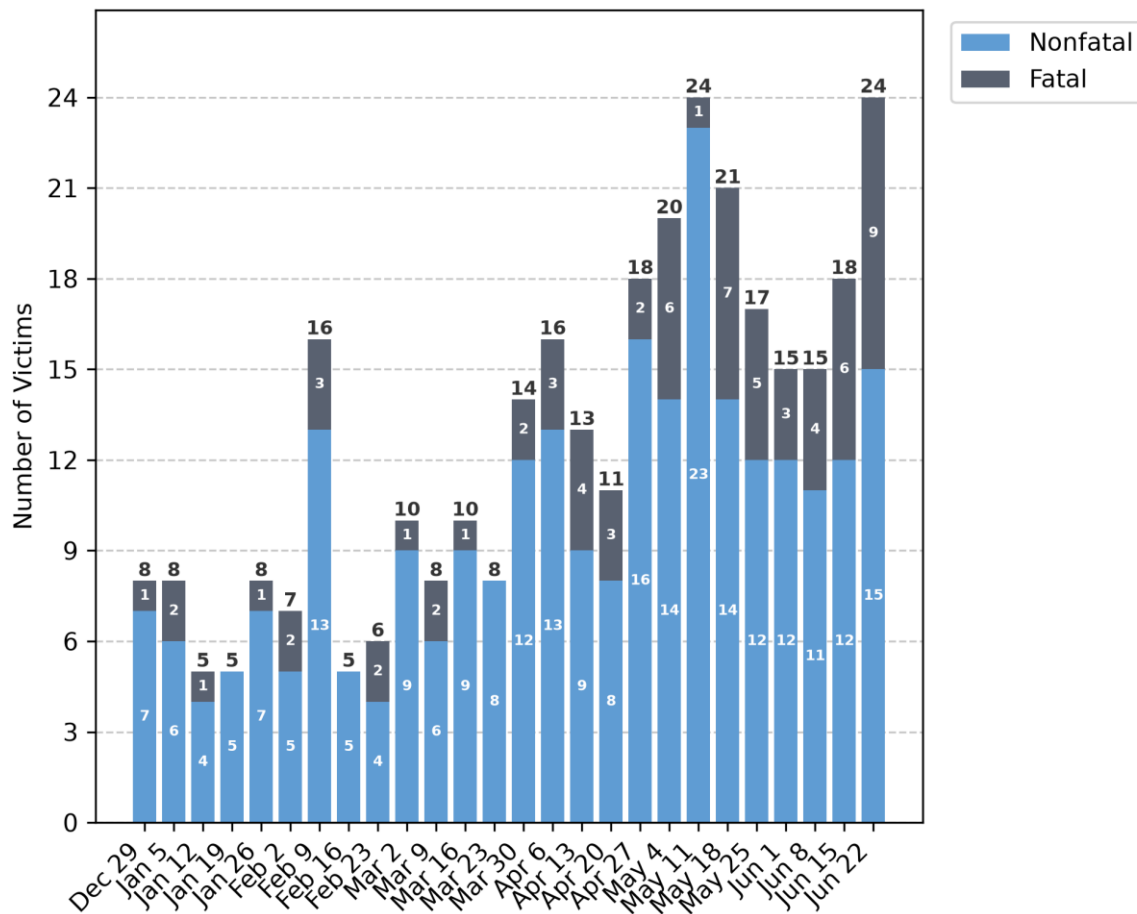

- There was one (1) 2-victim shooting incident reported in the public dataset on Monday, 6/22, at 5:32 PM, on the 2800 Block of S 10th St in the Snyder-Whitman neighborhood of the 19148 ZIP code.
 - News reports indicate that this shooting was a murder-suicide. Public data show two white female victims: a 55-year-old and 18-year-old. 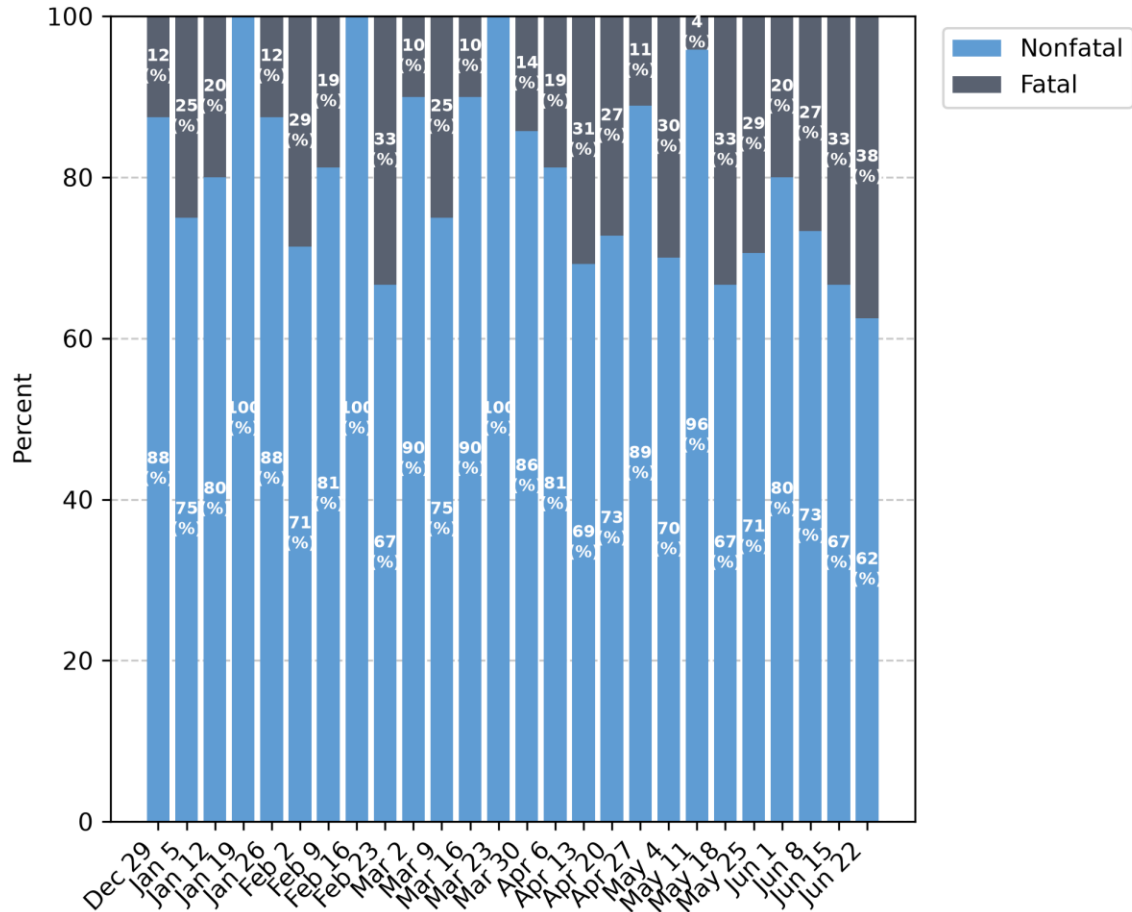
Of the 24 shooting victims during the week of June 22nd, public data indicates there were 9 victims who lost their lives.

- There were 9 fatal shootings in the public data for the week of June 22nd.
 - In 3 of the previous 4 weeks, a majority of fatal shootings had occurred in the 22nd and 25th police districts. This week, fatal shootings were more equally distributed across 7 police districts.
 - Beyond a single murder-suicide incident involving 2 reported female victims, 8 of 9 fatal shooting incidents involved single-victim incidents with male victims.

A Closer Look at Fatal Shootings

- On Tuesday, 6/23, at 3:58 PM, on the 900 Block of Frankford Ave in the Torresdale South-Pennypack Park neighborhood of the 19136 ZIP code, a 23-year-old Black man was killed while driving after 2 suspects pulled up beside his car and opened fire. <https://6abc.com/post/man-shot-killed-driving-frankford-avenue-torresdale-section-philadelphia/19365576/>
- On Tuesday, 6/23, at 8:30 PM, on the 3200 Block of W Clearfield St in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood of the 19132 ZIP code, 24-year-old Dasir Timbers was found shot in the head laying on the sidewalk near St. James school. Real-time crime cameras show a man in all black approach the victim before the shooting. A Closer Look at Fatal Shootings

- On Wednesday, 6/24, at 11:02 PM, on the 4000 Block of Gilham St in the Wissinoming-Tacony neighborhood of the 19135 ZIP code, a 24-year-old Black man was killed when returning to a rowhome. He was allegedly approached by three other men on the lawn. A confrontation ensued, and multiple shots were fired. At least 17 shell casings were found.

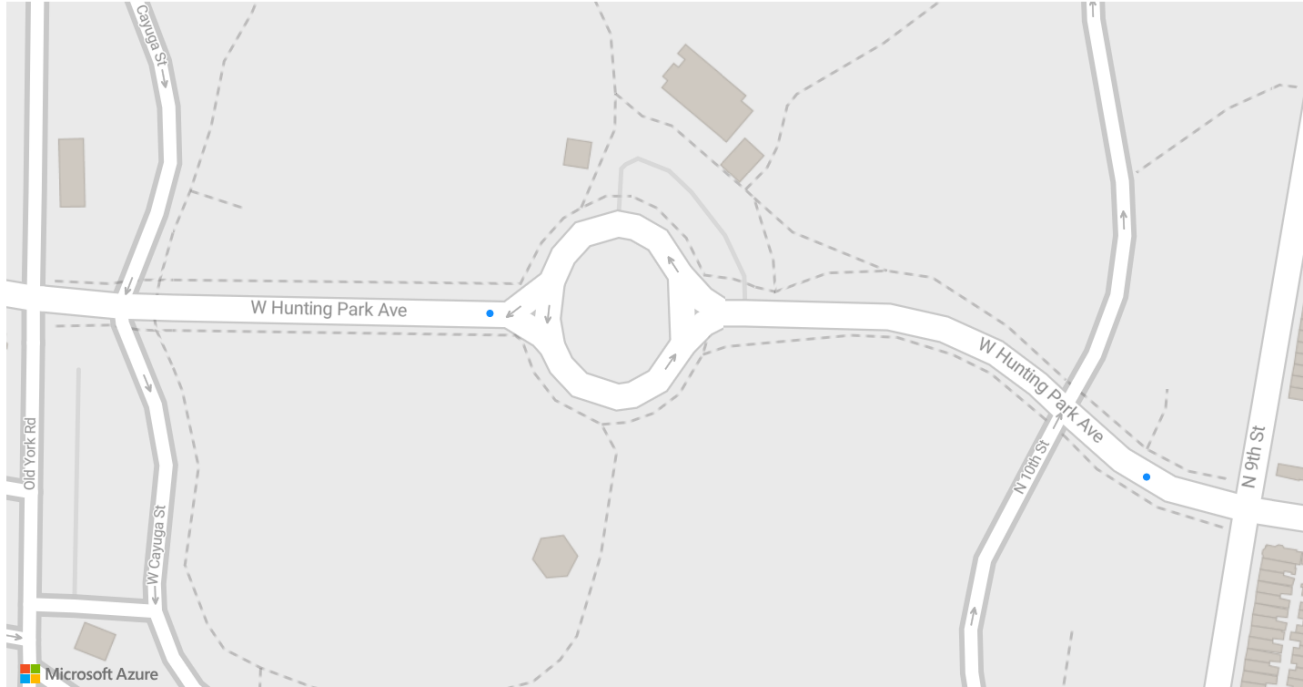
- On Friday, 6/26, at 8:39 PM, on the 800 Block of Palm St in the Mill Creek-Parkside neighborhood of the 19104 ZIP code, a 27-year-old Hispanic man was killed in a car with a woman and kids present. They had apparently driven from New Jersey for a Facebook marketplace meetup - believed to be for a phone. It seems that a gun was shown, the man tried to drive away, and the gunmen shot him multiple times. - On Sunday, 6/28, at 3:50 AM on the 1200 Block of N 52nd St in the Mill Creek-Parkside neighborhood of the 19131 ZIP code, a 62-year-old Black man was shot and killed at the 227 Bar and Lounge. News stories indicate that this incident began when two employees began arguing over closing duties. - On Friday, 6/20, at 10:55 PM, on the 1200 Block of W Hunting Park in the Hunting Park-Fairhill neighborhood of the 19140 ZIP code, a 25-year-old Black man was found shot in the chest in a park. News articles indicate that detectives were looking to determine if this may be related to a similar incident the previous week (*see previous week details below*).

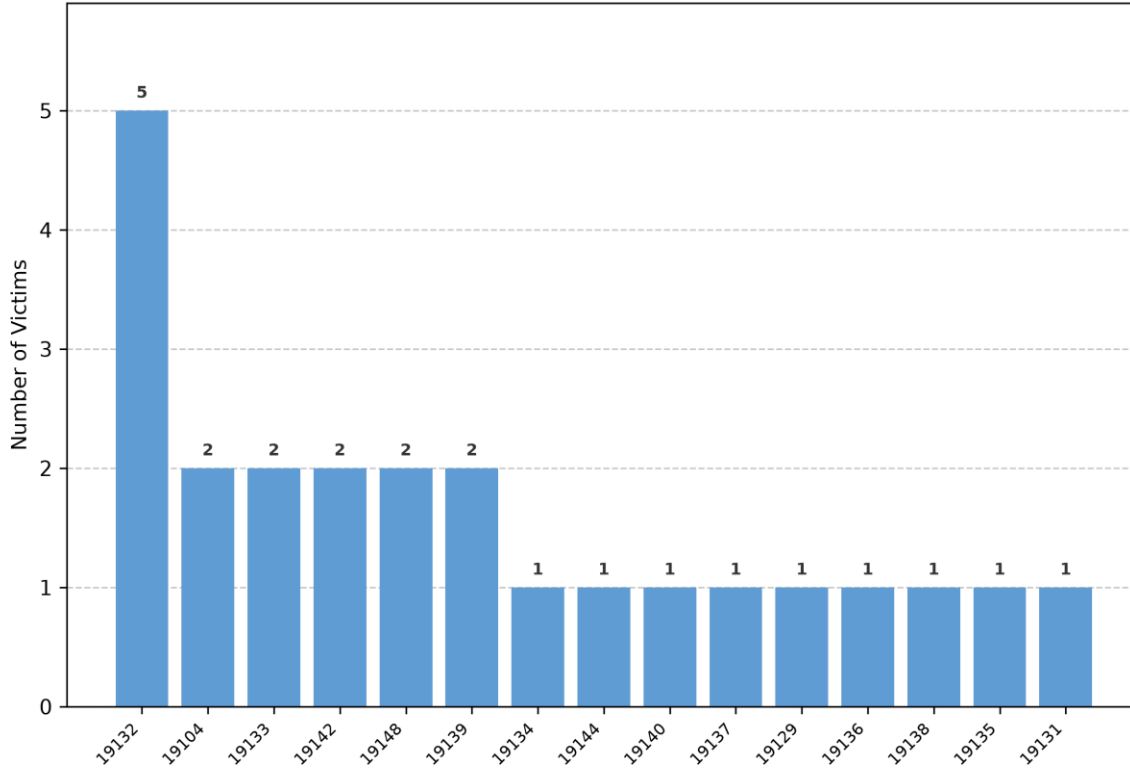

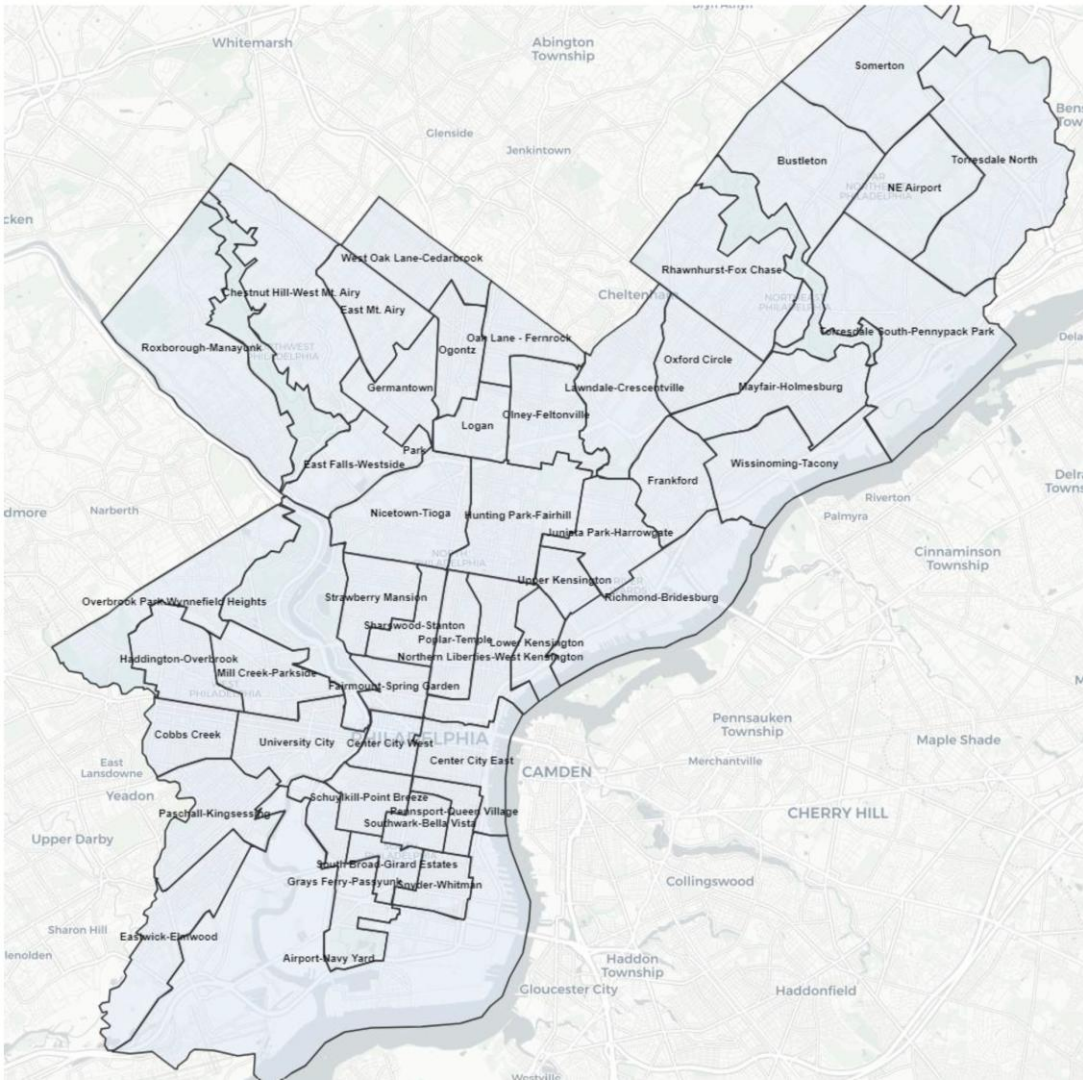

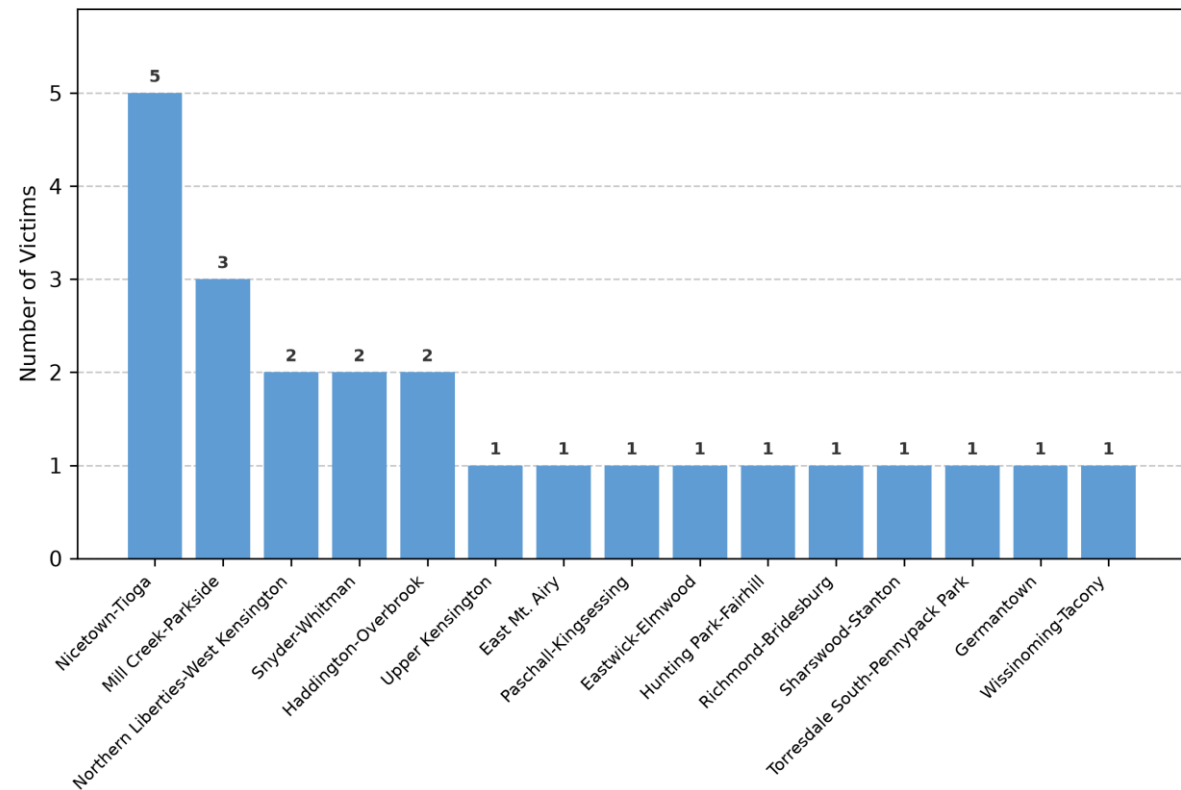

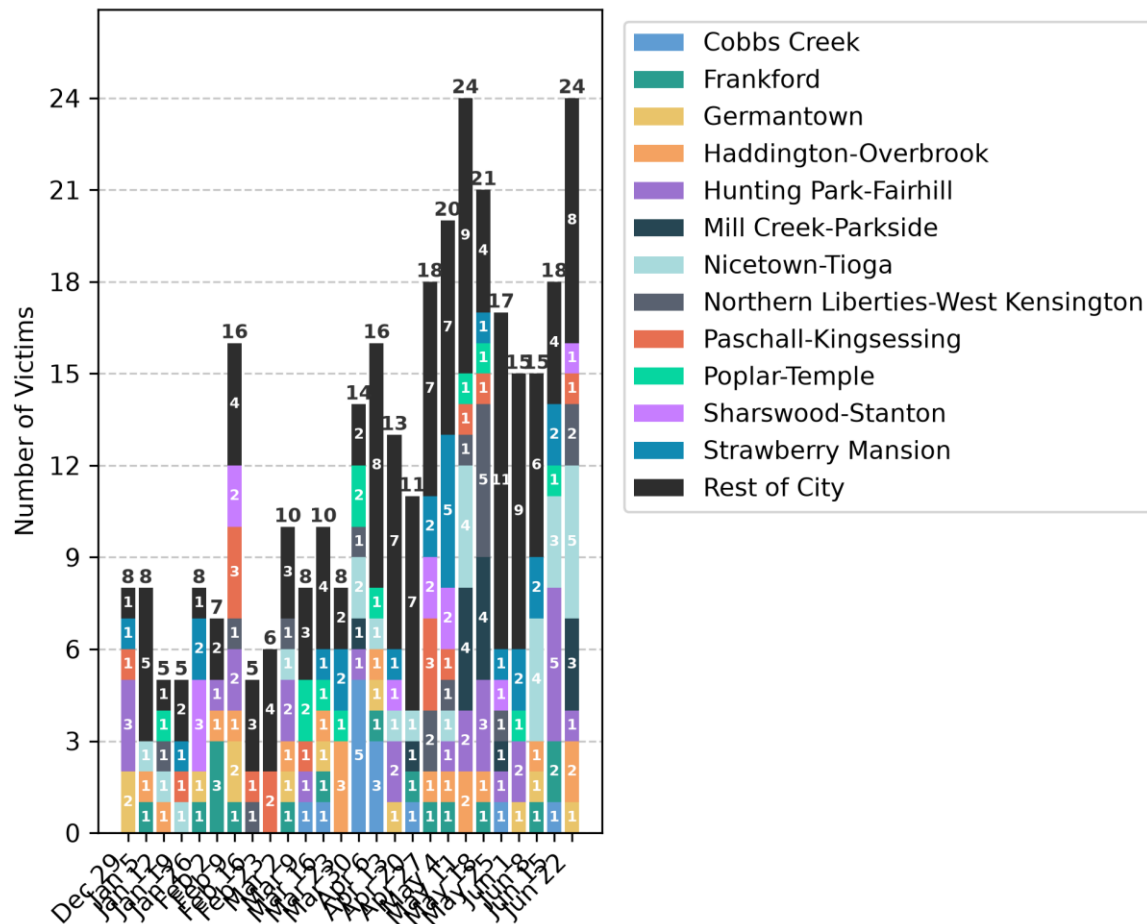

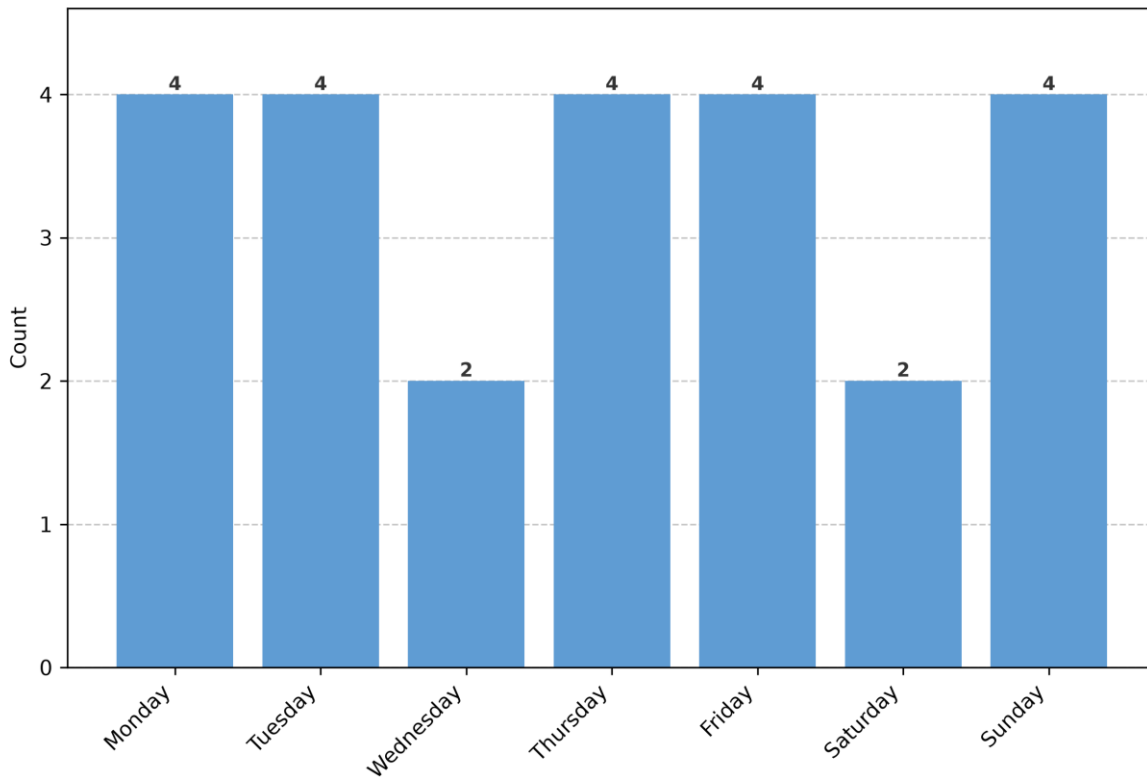

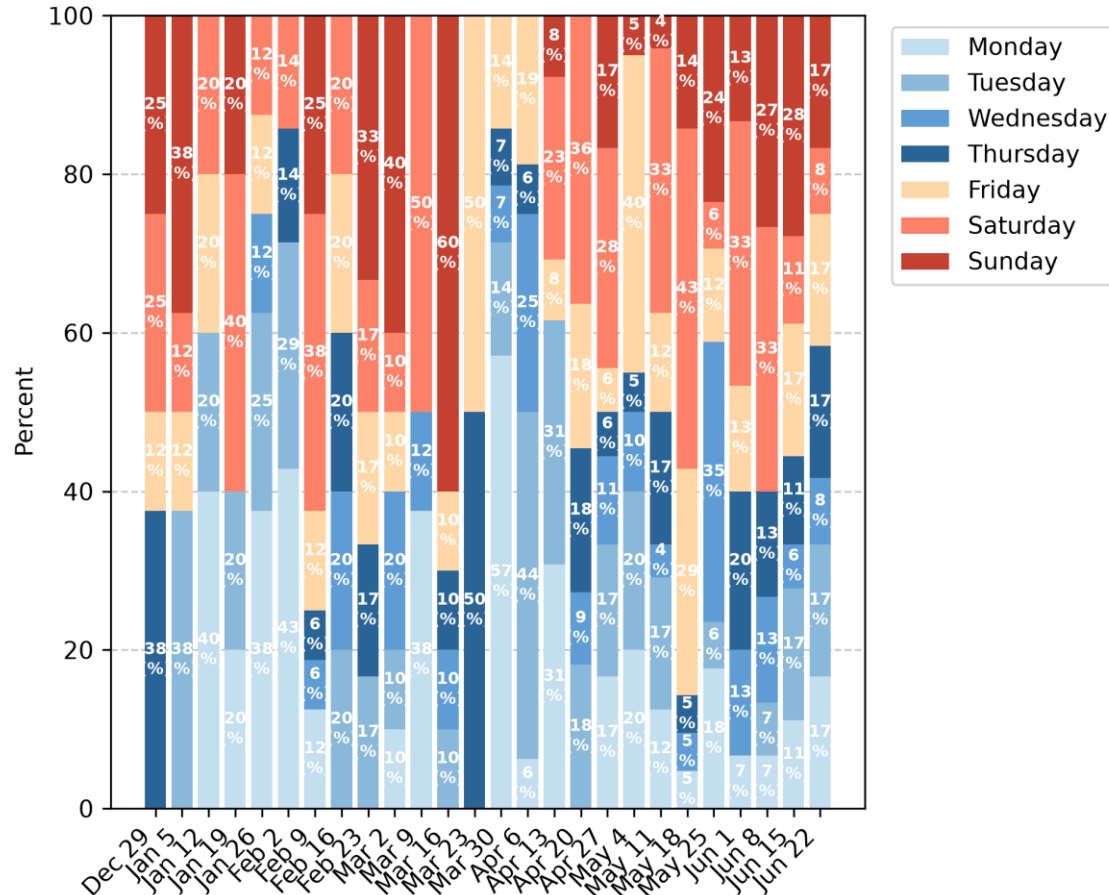

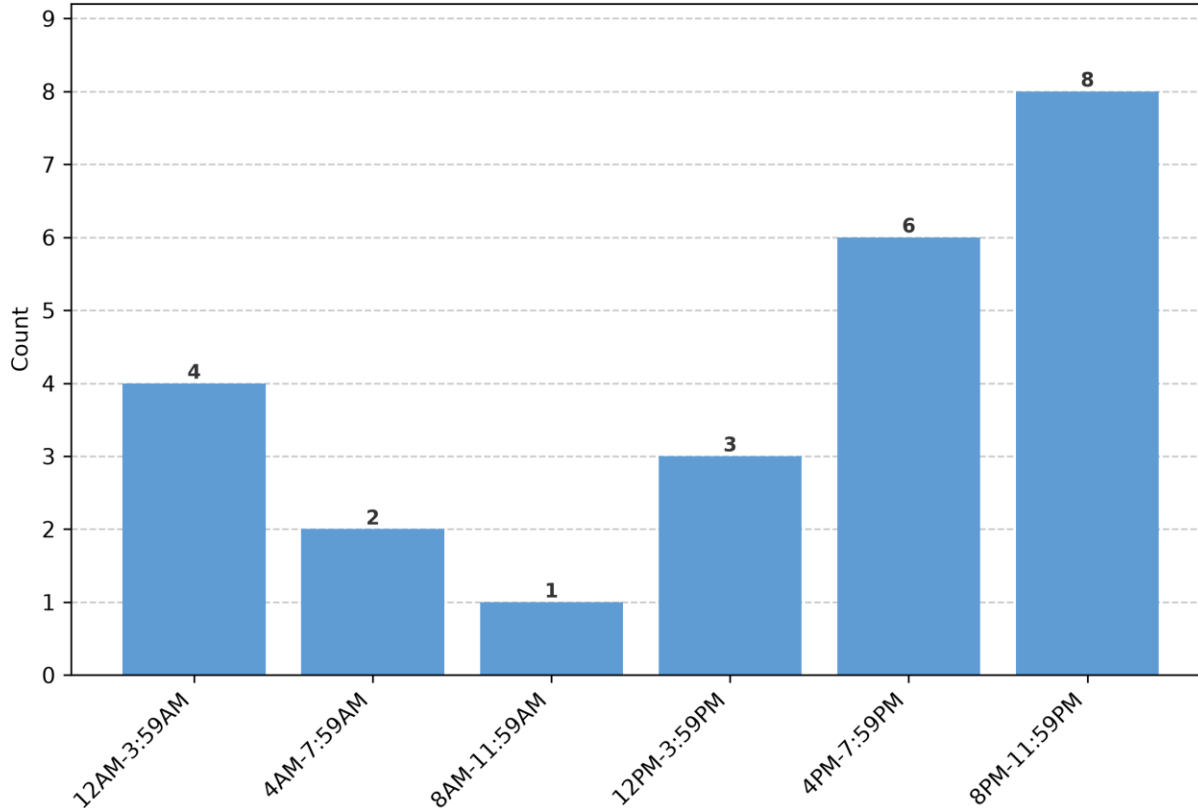


25% of shooting victims were shot on a Saturday or Sunday.

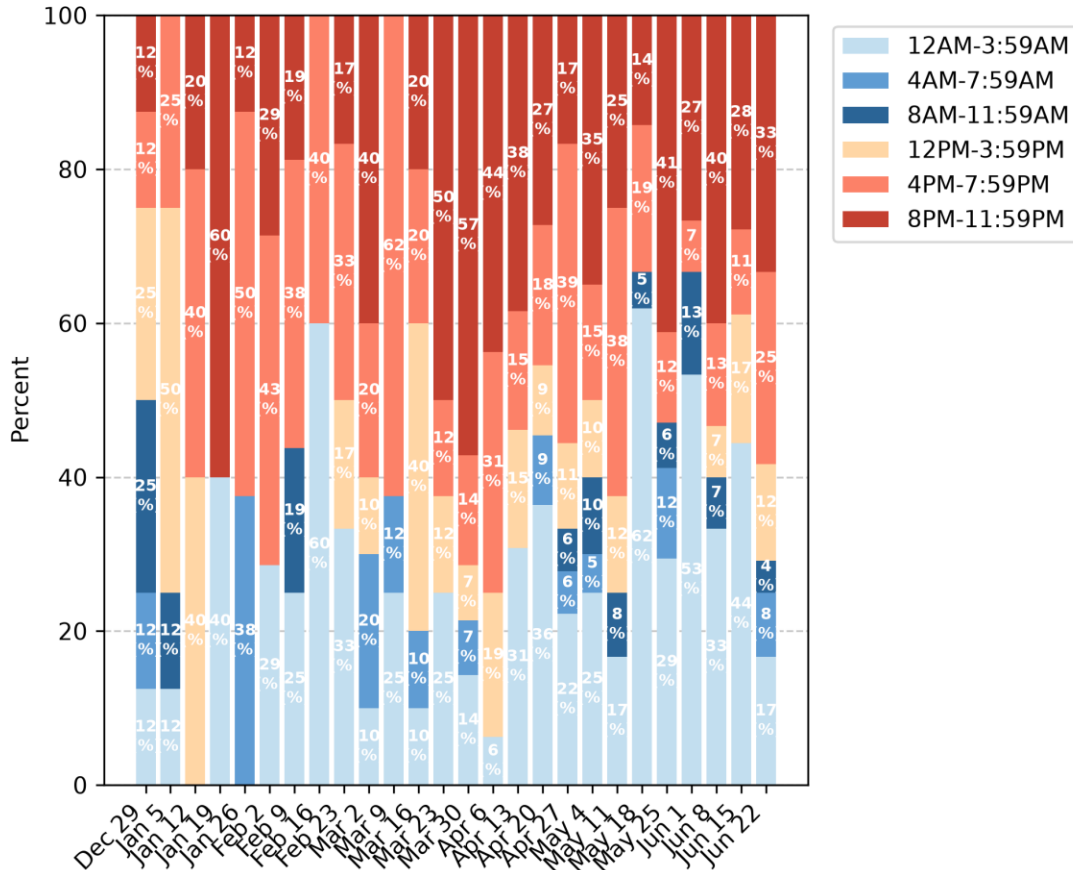

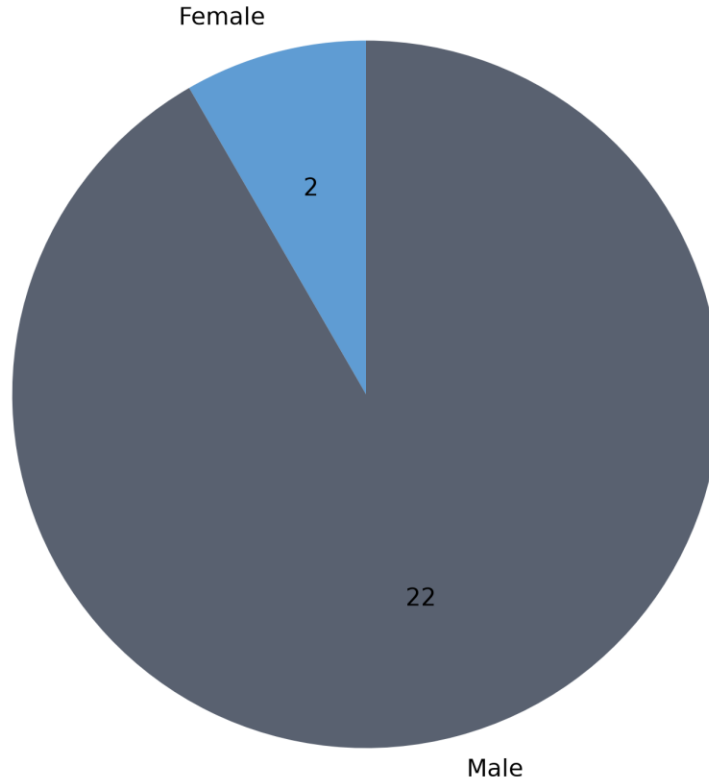

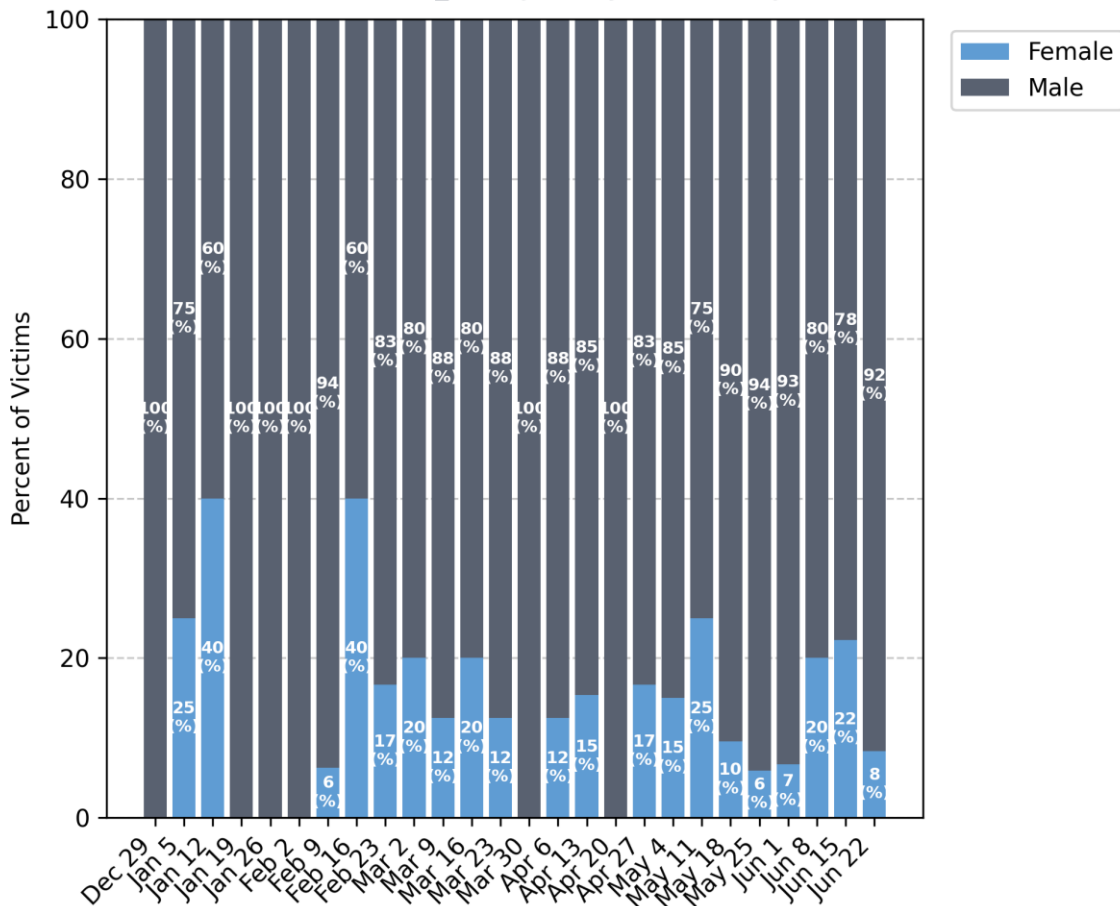

Victims by Sex - By Week (%)

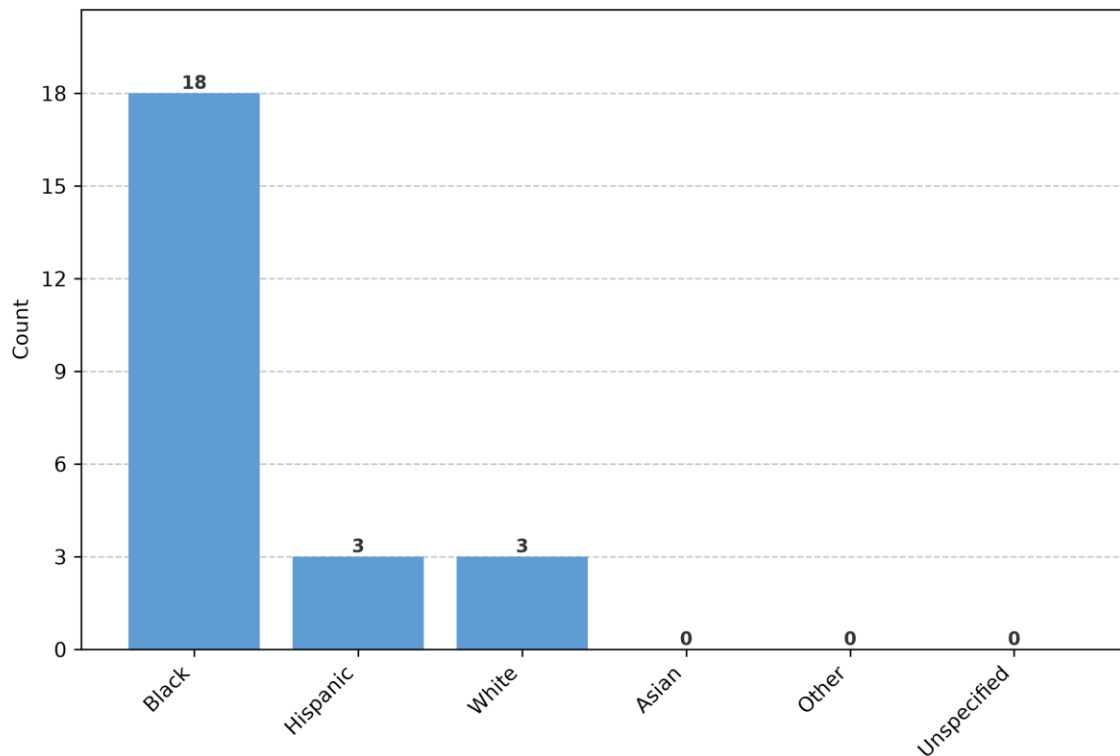

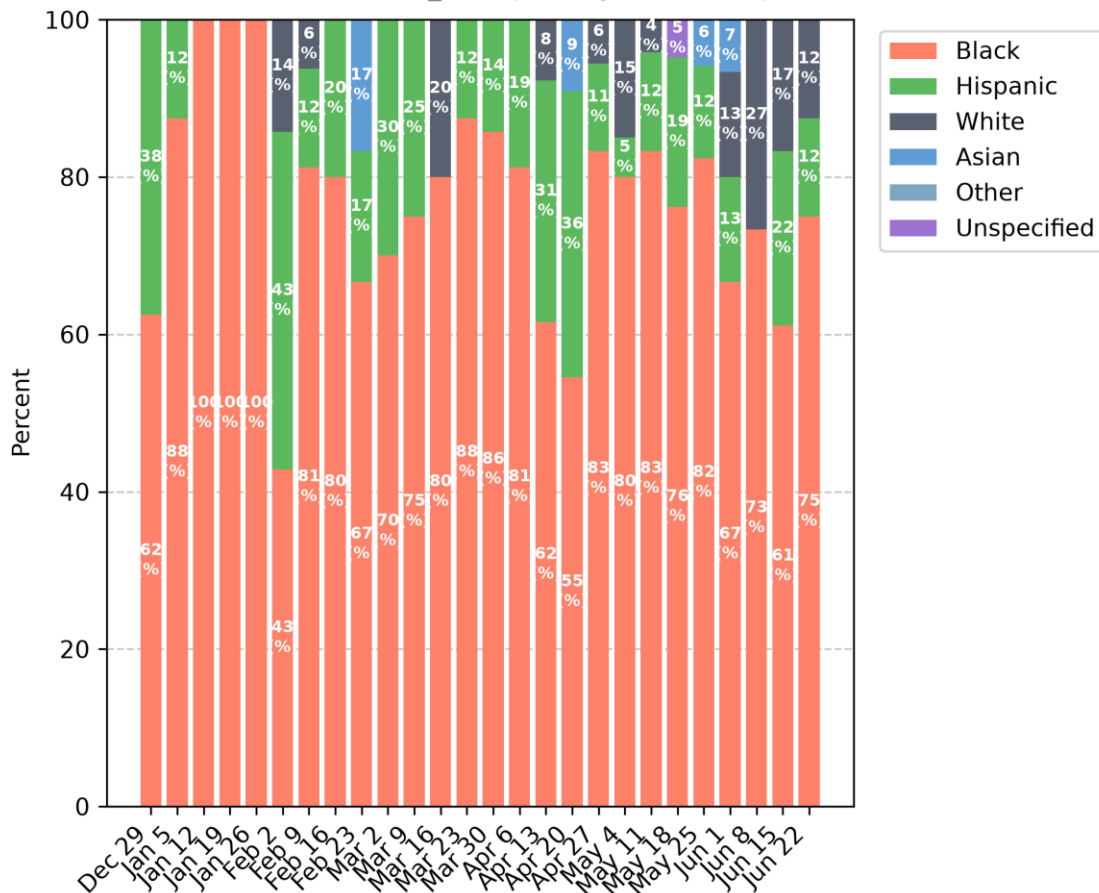

Victims by Race and Ethnicity - By Week (%)

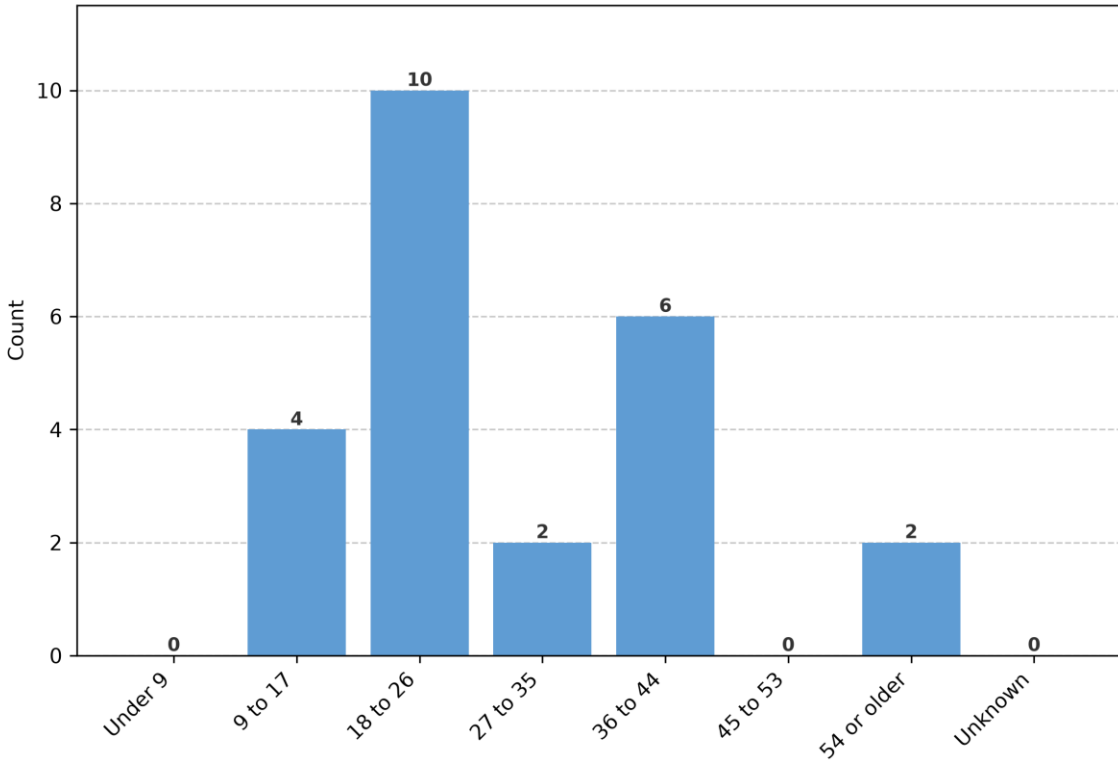

A CLOSER LOOK AT YOUTH SHOOTING VICTIMS

There were four (4) shootings of youth below the age of 18 on the week of June 22nd.

- All 4 youth shootings involved a single-victim.
- All 4 youth shootings involved a male victim between the ages of 15 and 17.
- All 4 youth shootings happened between the hours of 4 PM and 11:59 PM.
- 2 of 4 youth shooting incidents happened within 2-hours of each other in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood.

A Closer Look at Youth Shootings

- On Thursday, 6/25, at 7:10 PM, on the 2400 Block of W Cambria St in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood of the 19132 ZIP code, a 16-year-old Black male was non-fatally shot twice in the leg. Police found blue surgical gloves which the shooter was allegedly wearing.
 - Two hours later, at 9:10 PM, on the 3200 Block of N 25th St in the Nicetown-Tioga neighborhood, a 17-year-old Black male was shot in the leg by a suspect who may have exited a nearby property. Police were working to see if these shootings may have been connected to a fight that happened on a playground earlier. <https://6abc.com/post/fight-playground-may-connected-2-separate-shootings-involving-teens-north-philadelphia-police/19386633/>

A Closer Look at Youth Shootings

- On Sunday, 6/28, at 4:52 PM, at the intersection of Baynton St and East Walnut in the East Mt. Airy neighborhood of the 19144 ZIP code, a 15-year-old Black male was non-fatally shot in the hand after a fight with 2 other young men. News reports indicate that the 3 young men were riding e-bikes or scooters with one another when they got into an argument in front of a corner store. The argument then escalated and one of the suspects pulled out a gun and shot the victim in the hand.

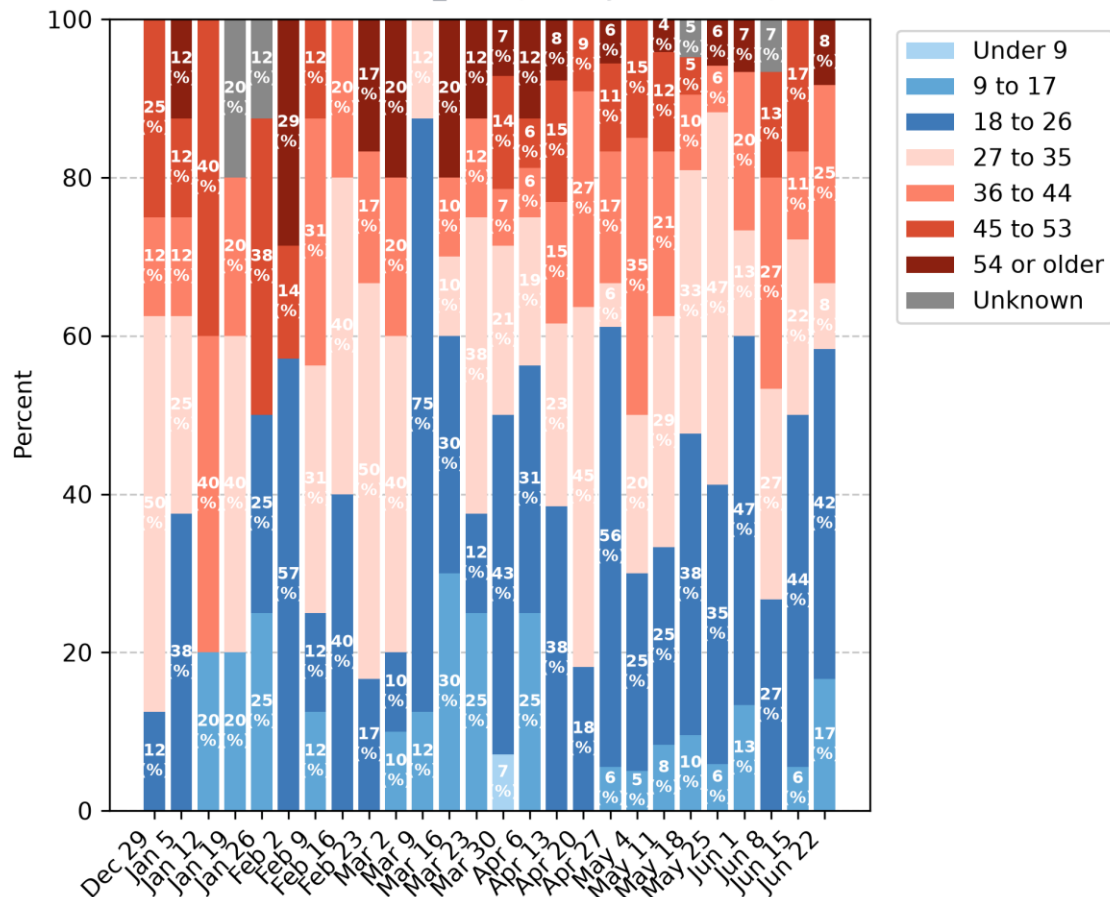
